<u>WORKING TEST INTERMEDIATE</u> - The Working Certificate Intermediate Test shall be for all retrievers and standard poodles who have earned a WC title. The Tests for WCI shall be: (1) land double, (2) honour on the land test, (3) water double

WORKING TEST EXCELLENT - The Working Certificate Excellent Test shall be for all retrievers and standard poodles who have earned a WCI title. The tests for WCX shall be: (1) walk-up test with a land double or a land/water double, (2) honour on the walk-up, (3) water double, (4) land blind, (5) water blind
