Motor home generators must be vented upward, and as a courtesy to your fellow campers, generators will need to be turned off between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. Ground is uneven; arrive prepared to level your unit. Please maintain appropriate social distancing (12 feet / 4 Metres) between camping units. #### **Equipment**

NO toys that make squeaky sounds will be permitted within 15 feet of the rings.

Equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day, and High traffic touch points will be sanitized throughout the day.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials (weather permitting).



#### The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes:

Handlers are responsible for entering the correct height division. The judge may request any dog be measured.

Selected Class dogs will jump one height lower than the equivalent regular class height shown in the table below and dogs who measure 10" or below will jump 4" in the Selected Class. Veteran dogs may jump one or two heights lower.

8 inches for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers

12 inches for dogs over 11 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers

16 inches for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers

20 inches for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers

24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

The following breeds, or mixed breed dogs that resemble these breeds in relation to weight to shoulder height ratios, are permitted (but not required) to jump either ONE or TWO jump height(s) lower than the designated shoulder height when they show in the Selected division.

Small Breeds: Basset Hound, Bulldog, Cesky Terrier, Clumber Spaniel, Dachshund (all 6 varieties), Dandie Dinmont Terrier, French Bulldog, Pekingese, Petit Basset Griffon Vendeen, Scottish Terrier, Sealyham Terrier, Skye Terrier, Welsh Corgi (Cardigan & Pembroke)

Giant Breeds: Bernese Mountain Dog, Black Russian Terrier, Bloodhound, Bullmastiff, Great Dane, Great Pyrenees, Greater Swiss Mountain Dog, Irish Wolfhound, Leonberger, Mastiff, Neopolitan Mastiff, Newfoundland, Saint Bernard

**Precincts of the trial:** All grounds within 100' of the ring areas or the fenced area of the grounds, whichever is less, shall be considered the trial grounds.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any inMONngement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred".

This is a limited Entry Show – 300 dogs per day per judge but that maximum may need to be reduced to accommodate Federal, Provincial and Local Covid 19 recommendations. NO entries will be processed prior to June 11<sup>th</sup>. Mailed entries will be kept in the order that they are received until this time. Should the trial need to be cancelled prior to June 11<sup>th</sup> NO entry fees will be processed. If the trial needs to be cancelled between June 11<sup>th</sup> and July 12<sup>th</sup> ALL entry fees will be refunded. Any Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or etransfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded.

Regular Entries close June 28, 2021 at 9pm MST OR WHEN LIMIT IS REACHED! In the event the limit is reached, the trial secretary will keep a waitlist.

## Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta / Wet Noses Inc. COVID-19 Requirements

When you receive your entry confirmation a complete list of Covid requirements will be attached. Should you wish to withdraw your entry between the time that you mail in your entries and when entries close you will receive a full refund of <a href="entry fees">entry fees</a> (any Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or etransfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded.) However, after June 28<sup>th</sup> at 9pm MST entry fees will ONLY be refunded if RMWHCA should cancel the trial OR as per CKC Rule 6.11.1, or due to a bitch in season (see complete rules for both below). All Covid Rules MUST be followed by all exhibitors, and they may be subject to change should the Provincial or Federal Covid-19 Restriction's change

## MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED BY <u>ALL</u> EXHIBITORS AT <u>ALL</u> TIMES – INCLUDING WHEN RUNNING YOUR DOG. THIS **MAY** CHANGE CLOSER TO THE TRIAL.

Entry to the agility zones / agility rings will be granted only to those wearing a face mask. Individuals who are unable to wear a face mask due to a medical condition must wear a face shield. Exhibitors / participants must wear a face mask or shield that covers their nose and mouth at all times in the agility zones / agility rings/ or within 9 feet of ANY other exhibitor or show volunteer.

FFO\* (For Fun Only) Runs are NOT included in the discounted total run fee. No refunds will be given for any difference in fees already paid if an exhibitor switches a regular run to an FFO run at the trial.

ALL credit card, Apple pay, Interac or etransfers will be processed through the dogshow.ca and will incur a 5% charge.



Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated. Thank You.

TCN Fees: A CKC TCN fee of \$10.50 (GST Incl.) Canadian or US per dog per trial is payable with the entry fee if the entry of the dog does not include a CKC individual Registration number, ERN (Event Registration Number), PEN (Performance Event Number), MCN (Miscellaneous Certificate Number) or Companion Number. The Temporary Competition Number MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCN's will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). If a CKC registration number is received after the closing date but prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue. TCN fees will not be refunded.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible to compete in this trial, a dog must be at least 18 months of age and registered with the CKC or eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, MCN or Companion Number. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in the trial however, entry and TCN fees will be returned, providing a veterinarian's certificate stating that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial is submitted to the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial.

**Move-up option:** Move Ups will be allowed 1 hour prior to the start of each trial.

**Exhibitor Information:** Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the current CKC Agility Rules and Regulations. A copy of which may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of CKC at 1-800-250-8040.

All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete: Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog(s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made – no refunds are given due to an error in entries. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full entry fees. The club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.

#### **Refunds**

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the starting date and the time of the trial. The Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta will refund entry, recording and TCN fees if the above conditions are met. A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a Veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Trial Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Trial Chairperson to verify she is in season.

Per rule 6.11.1 of the Agility Trials Rules and Regulations, if a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3-day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta will refund 90% of the entry fees only.

Entry fees will **not** be funded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, strikes, Federal, Provincial or Local requirements or any other cause beyond the control of the Club. Should the trial need to be cancelled due to Covid 19 ALL entry fees will be refunded. Any Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or etransfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded.

Refunds will be MAILED to the exhibitor.

#### **General Rules Governing these Trials**

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Agility Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (<a href="https://www.ckc.ca">www.ckc.ca</a>)

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the agility trial. The Trial Chairperson shall have full control of the above trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Trial Chairperson for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any inMONngement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the trial grounds.







### Summary of CKC rule changes for 2020 for Exhibitors

Prepared by Wendy Beard of the CKC Agility Council For the complete rules please see the CKC January 2021 Agility Rule Book.

#### **New Category**

#### Senior Handlers and Handlers with Disability

- Senior handlers (65 years and over) and handlers with disability may request a modified course time or a modified points requirement (PAD) (see tables below).
- Proof of disability or age will not be requested by the host club. A handler must indicate on the entry form if entering as senior/disabled handler (check S/D box) to receive modified times/reduced number of points.
- The handler's dog shall be entered at its current competition jump height and category. (Time and points concession is for the handler)
- For Standard, JWW, Steeplechase and J&T, the score table will subtract the time prior to scoring the run, regardless of whether the dog was under the SCT for that division and category or not.
- For PAD, the score table will add 3 points prior to scoring the run.

#### **Modified Course Times**

CLASS	MODIFIED TIME (More Time Allowed)
Standard, 144 W, Steeplechase, 3&1	If course is under 150 yards, subtract 5 seconds from dog's time. If course is 150 yards or more, subtract 10 seconds from dog's time.

#### **Reduced Points Requirement for Pad**

LEVEL	REDUCED POINTS REQUIREMENT
Novice	3 points less (add 3pts to dog's total)
Intermediate	3 points less (add 3pts to dog's total)
Excellent/Master	3 points less (add 3pts to dog's total)

#### For Fun Only Class

- At the owner's discretion, dogs are able to run in For Fun Only (FFO) class in any category. The owner would be allowed to take their dog into the ring with a toy. Toys are allowed but the toy must be identified to the judge prior to entering the ring. A maximum course time of 60 seconds would be allotted.
- FFO entries must meet all eligibility rules as dogs running for Qualification. FFO runs may be allowed at the same or a lesser fee at the club's discretion.
- A handler may choose to enter an FFO dog in any class, in any trial, at any performance level and at any jump height. Obstacle repetition is permitted without dismissal. They are not allowed to enter the same class again for a qualifying run. Dogs must attempt to run the course as numbered and are under the same judging criteria as dogs that are running for qualification.

#### **Grand Agility Master Champion (G.Ag.M.Ch)**

The Grand Agility Master Champion recognizes dogs that show consistency and verTUEility across all classes of the CKC agility program.

The CKC will permit the use of the letters G. Ag.M.CH. signifying Grand Agility Master Champion title, to be used in connection with and before the name of each dog which has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided To be permitted to use Grand Agility Master Champion title a dog must earn the following number of qualifying.

- 50 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Standard Class
- 50 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class
- 25 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Points and Distance Class
- 25 Qualifying scores in the Steeplechase Class

Selected and Veterans will earn a title with the letter S or V after the title. Qualifying Scores previously earned in these classes will be used towards this title.

#### **Competitors**

- New category for Senior/Disabled Handlers
- New option to run For Fun Only with toy at any height and in any class
- Entry clarification: handlers may opt to enter their dog to jump at a higher height than their measured height for all Regular classes
- Height cutoff changes for dogs 11" and under. Dogs measuring 11' and under jump a Regular height of 8". The Selected/Veteran height will be 4"
- A select list of breeds, or mixed breed dogs that resemble these breeds in relation to weight to shoulder height ratios, are permitted (but not required) to jump either ONE or TWO jump height(s) lower than the designated shoulder height when they show in the Selected division. (See rulebook 8.5.5 for list)
- The CKC will permit the use of the letters AG.M.CH2, and so on signifying an Agility Master Champion earned a second time, third or fourth time, to be used in connection with and before the name of each dog
- New title Grand Agility Master Champion GAgMCh (see section 8.20)
- No toys that make a squeaking sound are permitted within 15ft of the ring
- Time from end of walkthrough to first dog may range from 3-5 minutes. Time judging starts must be announced at the start of the walkthrough.





No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, strikes, Federal, Provincial or Local requirements or any other cause beyond the control of the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta.

Should the trial need to be cancelled due to Covid 19 all <u>entry fees</u> will be refunded. Any Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or etransfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian (except as written in this Premium List) or the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
