New as of March 2, 2020 Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN)

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Until March 2, 2020 dogs may still be entered into CKC events without a registration number or ERN by marking "TCN" on the entry form (or "Listed" if it is an old entry form). However, an e-mail address will be required. Before you apply for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if CKC has already created a TCN for them. There will be a tab for TCN Dogs on the Owner's Portal account.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

CLASSIFICATION-CONFORMATION: The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

<u>12 - 18 MONTH CLASS</u> 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS -shall be for all Dogs.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY</u> - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

<u>VETERAN CLASS</u> - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed

Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS</u> - Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex).

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Held under CKC Rules and Regulations and as printed in the show catalogue Saturday May 16, 2020 & Sunday May 17, 2020 over the lunch hour.

A rosette and suitable prize will be awarded to the winners of First in each class; flat ribbons will be given to 2nd through 4th in each class. Peewee handlers will receive a Participant ribbon and prize.

BEST OWNER-HANDLED DOG IN GROUP AND SHOW

The handler of the dog must be the owner of record or a direct family member. The owner must show the dog at all levels of competition. This competition is open to non-professionals only. Anyone who has handled dogs for which they have received any compensation in any capacity in the past 2 years is not eligible to participate.

There are no additional fees for this event. Participants do not need to pre-register but the dogs must be entered in a regular conformation class.

<u>DATES:</u> Friday, May 15, 2020 Show #1 under judge Denise Cornelssen TIME: Following Puppy in Group and Puppy in Show

Owner-Handled competition is an unofficial class. Participants do not need to pre-register but will need to inform the ring steward following the breed judging that they are the owner. The handler of the dog must be the owner for the classes. Only owner-handled dogs that receive a Best of Breed ribbon are eligible to compete in the Best Owner Handled Dog in Group. The winner of BOH in breed may compete in BOH in Group unless the dog was already defeated at the Best in Group level, by another owner-handled dog. The winner of BOH in Group will compete in BOH in Show after the completion of Best Puppy in Show unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best in Show level, by another owner-handled dog that is entered in this competition

OTHER EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.6

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information, may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. Registered with the CKC
- b. Have an Event Registration Number
- c. Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. With the exception of Baby Puppy, if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

INDIGNITIES - SECTION 19.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
 - 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$107.80 + GST (CKC member) or \$161.60 + GST (non-member) which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators.
- 14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

It Is The Responsibility Of The Exhibitor To Be Familiar With The Rules Pertaining To The Event In Which They Are Competing. The "Dog Show Rules & Obedience Regulations Are Available From:

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

Championship Points

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided here under.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;

be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);

have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:

Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or

all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Best in Show (5 points)

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship.

A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system

Grand Champion Zincenene Point System	
Win	Points
First in Group or Best in Specialty Show	5
Second in Group of Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4
Third in Group	3
Fourth in Group (Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	2
Best of Breed (To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	1
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.

The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Additional Requirements To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this
