#### CLASSES OFFERED

Instinct, Novice - Container, Interior, Exterior; Open - Container, Interior, Exterior; Excellent - Container, Interior, Exterior, Master - Container; Interior, Exterior, Entry Limit - 90 Runs (Maximum 25 Instinct Tests)

#### RIBBONS

A Rossette will be awarded to all Novice, Open, Excellent and Master new titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive ribbons (flat) A suitable Rosette will be provided to dogs earning their Instinct Test.

1. One dog per handler per division.

2. The CDC respectfully asks that no posting of testing be placed on social media until end of trial.

3. The only dog permitted in trial area is dog being tested; no dogs allowed with spectators.

4. No Prong Collars.

5. No internal kenneling. All dogs must be under control on a leash except during the test.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

All entry fees must be in the hands of our Show Secretary prior to closing date.

Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to the COBEQUID DOG CLUB. No post-dated cheques accepted.

All NSF cheques and declined credit cards will be subject to a charge of \$40.00.

N.S.F. cheques are considered non -payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trial.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows and Trials are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or On Line. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

## IMPORTANT



To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the trial secretaries after the closing time and date. *Important Note* Regarding Emails & Faxes It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of

receipt by recipients. **NOTE:** All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via The Entry Line. The Cobequid Dog Club **does not** accept credit cards for payment.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Conformation Show Rules Sec. 19.7)
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the CDC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows, no refund of entry fees will be made
- Only dogs entered in the Show will be permitted on the show premises.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

#### ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non -Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. ### **COVID-19 EVENT PROTOCOLS**

The Dog Show is NOT OPEN to the General Public or Spectators. Due to NS Government COVID restrictions, only people DIRECTLY involved in the Trialing of the exhibit should be on-site. If you cannot comply with these rules for public safety,

## Please Do Not Enter or Attend! There will be no loopholes.

### **General Safety Practices**

- The Cobequid Dog Club and all show participants will follow federal, provincial, local and guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines. Do not congregate in groups larger than five; or within your own family circle only.
- When an exhibitor is done for the day, they must leave the show site in order to minimize congregating.
- Parking will only be in designated areas.

#### WAIVERS & SITE ACCESS

Waiver must be signed by everyone within the Show precincts (Building, Grounds, & Parking Lot). To be valid, the Questionnaire & Waiver must be dated within the 14 days prior to the last day of the show. No electronic copies of the Questionnaire & Waiver will be accepted.

## No Waiver, No Entry... No Excuses.

### MASKS

- 1. The correct wearing of masks (covering the mouth & nose) is mandatory, by all event participants, at all times while within the precincts of the event.
- 2. The only time masks may be removed is while eating or drinking & then the mask must be immediately put on again. If exhibitors are sitting in their vehicles, masks may be removed.
- 3. In the event someone has a medical exemption from wearing a mask, then sadly they will have to secure someone to handle their dog(s) for them. While we respect medical exemptions; however, we also have to respect keeping others as safe as we can.
- 4. If you use disposable masks, we ask that you cut the strings/elastics before properly disposing of the masks in the garbage.
- 5. People without a mask will be asked to leave the event.
- 6. Masks will not be provided by, or be available from, the Cobequid Dog Club.

#### HAND WASHING, SANITIZER & DISPOSABLE GLOVES

- Each Judge's & Ring Steward's table will have hand sanitizer on it (for use by Judge & Ring Steward).
- Wearing disposable gloves is not encouraged. The COVID virus gets on them in the same way it gets on your hands. Your hands can get contaminated when you take off the gloves.
- Signage will be posted throughout the facility to emphasize the importance of frequent handwashing & proper hygiene practices.
- Hand Sanitizing stations will be available.
- Exhibitors are also encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- Everyone is encouraged to wash their hands as often as possible.

### SOCIAL DISTANCING

• Mandatory 2 meters Social Distancing will be maintained at all times (unless you are within your designated 'bubble').

### RIBBONS

- Judges will not touch or present ribbons. The Ring Steward will place the ribbons for the class on the table at the ring exit. Please be sure that, as an exhibitor, you know what ribbon(s) you have earned. The Judge will be clear in their placement indication.
- Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbon(s) as they exit the ring.
- NO RECYCLING of ribbons. If you do not wish to keep your ribbons, please do not touch the ribbons.

## SAFETY MEASURES AND PROCEDURES

#### COMPLIANCE

To comply with NS Government gathering limit restrictions:

Anyone entering with EntryLine will have to sign the Questionnaire/Waiver (below) either when arriving at the venue, OR bring with them the Questionnaire & Waiver that will be included in the Judging Schedule.

In particular, Participants acknowledge that they are taking part in this event with full knowledge of the existence of the coronavirus pandemic and understand and accept that while the Cobequid Dog Club will make all reasonable effort to run a safe event, and will adhere to all Nova Scotia government coronavirus requirements and restrictions in force on the date of the event in doing so, it is impossible to eliminate all risk and by entering and attending the event, the participant accepts the risk of contracting COVID-19 and will absolve the Cobequid Dog Club and its members and Stay 'N Play Canine Centre of any liability in the event that they test positive for COVID-19 after this event.
