ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

JUVENILE & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Saturday

The HFC will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows. Each Class will be divided by sex.

Juvenile Classes: 4 – 6 Months; 6 – 9 Months; 9 – 12 Months; 12 –18 Months.

- 1st in Class: Ribbon and 25% of Class entry fees

- 3rd in Class: Ribbon and 10% of Class entry fees
- 4th in Class: Ribbon and 5% of Class entry fees

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CLASSES -The following CKC classes (divided by sex; except Specials Only) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.
12 - 18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs.
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered. Class will be divided by age.
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR AND UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show.
SIRE & GET <i>National Only</i>	This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and two (2) or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get MUST be entered in a regular class; Baby Puppies are ineligible.
DAM & PROGENY <i>National Only</i>	This class shall be comprised of the brood bitch and two (2) or more of her progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The brood bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. PROGENY must be entered in a regular class; Baby Puppies are ineligible.
BRACE <i>National Only</i>	This class shall be for two (2) dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by one (1) person on one (1) lead.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 Months)	Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Conformation Show Rules and Regulations** are available from the **Canadian Kennel Club** or can be viewed [online](#).
2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Event Secretary.
3. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – **Conformation Show Rules and Regulations** - Section 19.7.
4. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
5. The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).
6. No dog may be brought on the grounds or premises of an event if it:
 - Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases;
 - Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
 - Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded [here](#).

INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog.

NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Saturday

This event is for Havanese only. Dogs do not have to be owned by the handler but no bitches in season are allowed in this competition.

Entries will be accepted at the show secretary's desk up to one hour prior. No exceptions.

The following classes will be provided:
Pee Wee (non-competitive) - 4 to 6 years
Junior Novice - 7 to 10 years
Junior Open - 7 to 10 years
Intermediate Novice - 11 to 14 years
Intermediate Open - 11 to 14 years
Senior Novice - 15 to 18 years
Senior Open - 15 to 18 years

Competition is open to all Junior Handlers between the ages of 4 and up to 18 years of age (of the competition year). Pee Wees do not compete for best overall. Dogs handled by the juniors must be entered in a Regular Conformation class or in Exhibition Only at this breed specialty. Dogs do not need to be owned by the junior.

Pee Wees - participation rosette and prize

Best Overall Handler - rosette & prize, 1st - 4th in each class - rosette & prize

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from zero (0) to five(5)) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

A dog awarded Winners that also placed Reserve Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with four (4) championship points in addition to any points earned at the breed and group level, to the maximum allowed championship points in a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:

- a) Earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;
- b) Be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);
- c) Have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:

- a) At a single breed National Specialty, the male designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Bitch to have received five (5) points.
- b) At a single breed National Specialty, the female designated Reserve Winners Dog will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Dog to have received five (5) points.
- c) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;
- d) Each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing;
- e) All points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

GRAND CHAMPION (GCh)

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

- a) Grand Champion Point System - Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh: Select Dog = # of regular class dogs + # of specials dogs - 1, Select Bitch = # of regular class bitches + # of specials bitches - 1.

- b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at Group level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GChEx)

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) One (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)
- b) Three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.
- c) A CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE:

1. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until December 31, 2022.
