♦♦♦ GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS♦♦♦

Judging Schedules will be emailed and posted online

All exhibitors are required to ensure that their dogs eliminate in designated areas. All feces MUST be picked up and cleaned-up thoroughly – supplies will be available.

This specialty operates under the CKC Conformation Show Rules. As per these rules, the following sections are published here:

19 Discipline

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

15.1 Championship Points

15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
POINTS ALLOCATED	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners.In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excusedor ordered from the ring by the judge shall not beincluded in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

Non-Member Participation Fee

24.12.3 Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

OTHER RULES:

Respect for our Venue

As participants in the SWHDA Specialty Show we require you to **clean up** after your dogs and yourselves. This includes anything that would be considered litter. We want to leave the venue as clean or cleaner than when we arrived. Thank you for assisting us with this.

Covid-19 Safety Protocol for SWHDA 2021 Shows

If you cannot comply with these rules Do Not Enter or Attend!

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING.

Waiver must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Family Members, Friends etc.

No Ringside crating or tables allowed.

Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number)

Masks must be worn correctly over mouth & nose.

Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers.

Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring, NO RECYCLING of ribbons.

Masks <u>must</u> be worn correctly over mouth & nose. This is mandatory for Exhibitors, Judges, and Stewards. This is <u>mandatory</u> anywhere within show grounds and in the rings, parking areas, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth and in any other location.

Social Distancing 2 meters-6ft This is Mandatory in the rings, in parking area, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth.

At all times, upon arrival to the venue, a Covid 19 screening (series of questions), and your temperature will be taken. You must remain in your vehicles as you answer these questions. In ADDITION as STATED BEFORE your WAIVER MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED. The GATE KEEPER will collect these and give you a wrist band and your armband numbers,

There will be NO BENCHING inside or outside! This is a stay in your car until your designated ring time show. You are only allowed to arrive 30 minutes before your designated ring time, must remain in your vehicle at all times until your ring time, and leaving ASAP afterwards. Breed winners will return at a separate time for group competition.

Agents with four or more breeds will have designated parking to prevent line up congestion and conflicts.

They must stay in their vehicles at all times, unless to use the washroom or go to the ring.

You will receive a new wristband every day as well as given a new waiver every day,

Each dog entry MUST have a agent listed (even if it is being owner shown), If your name is not on the list of agents at the gate you will NOT be allowed in, This includes for assistants, owners, handlers etc.

Juniors handlers will be allowed a plus one for legal guardian, please email secretary to have junior and legal guardians name on the list.

Juniors must pre register. Please email show secretary for more information.

ADDITIONAL COVID INFORMATION

The Dog Show is NOT OPEN to the General Public.

Show Site Access Process: Waiver is to be handed into the club upon arrival at show site, attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only.

The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations, Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently.

No Public Catalogue will be available, know your numbers ahead of time! Come prepared.

Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks.

Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

Judging schedule will have specific time blocks, group judging will have specific start times, exhibitors are only allowed to arrive 30 minutes before ring times, and must leave immediately after showing.

If exhibitors have 4 plus breeds please contact show secretary to arrange special parking area to stay longer amounts of time.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY > Due to restrictions laid out by the province, all exhibitors must remain in their vehicles at all times other than for the purpose of exhibiting your dog.

- > Dogs cannot be groomed outside of your vehicle anywhere on site. No benching dogs outside of vehicles.
- > Judging schedule will have specific breed times, Exhibitors will be updated via Facebook page for whos in the ring incase of running behind

We need 100% cooperation from everyone.

- > Any deviation from 100% compliance will result in ejection from the show without refund.
