Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

The Trial giving club will refund the entry fee.

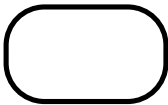

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6 -9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN.
- Include full payment in the amount of \$57.60 plus taxes. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.
- An ERN must be obtained within 30 day of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

1. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration, can be entered.
2. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.
3. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are filled in, ex. Birthdate, Class, Sex, Owners address etc.
4. **NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENTRY FEE.**
5. TELEPHONE entries cannot be accepted.
6. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing day is prohibited.
7. The Cornwall District Kennel Club has the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.
8. **THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT WILL BE IN FULL CHARGE OF THE SHOW**, which will be governed by CKC Rules
9. Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
10. The person accompanying the dog must show the identification card before the dog is allowed in the show. Unless a dog is officially entered, it will not be allowed in the show precincts.
11. Owners and handlers **MUST** clean up after their dogs.
12. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging time, and will be excused each show when not required for further judging.
13. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
14. The Show Committee and Diana Edwards Show Services will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
15. The show premises will open not later than one hour before scheduled judging times.
16. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show no refund of entry fee will be made.
17. To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loud-speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternant handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

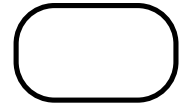

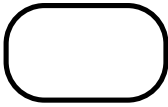
