Obedience Classes	
Pre-Novice	Pre-Novice is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter in the Novice class. Shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion) Dog in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 5 exercises unless they have 2 or more dogs entered. In such a case they must have an additions handler for each extra dog for judging of the group exercises.
Novice "A"	Open to any dog which has not earned a title of C.D in Canada. Only one dog per handler, and the handler must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate family. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX Title in Canada or Elsewhere will be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.
Novice "B"	The Novice B class shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs entered in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter and handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless they have 2 or more dogs entered. In such a case they must have an additions handler for each extra dog for judging of the group exercises. No Dog shall be entered in both the Novice A and the Novice B class in any one trial.
Novice "C"	Dogs entered in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may handle more than one dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless they have 2 or more dogs entered. In such a case they must have an additions handler for each extra dog for judging of the group exercises. Dogs may enter the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify the dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C Class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.
Novice Intermediate	The Novice Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Classes. It Shall be for any dog that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises. Dogs may enter the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned in the Novice Intermediate class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify the dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate Class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.
Open "A"	The Open A class is for any dog that has earned a title of C.D. in Canada but has not earned the title of C.D.X. in Canada. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. If a dog is wrongfully entered in this calls, any score awarded will be cancelled.
Open "B"	The Open B Class is for any dog which has earned a title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X or higher obedience titles may enter the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in Utility in the same trial. Dogs entered in this class may be handled by the owner or by any other person. A person may handle more than one dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless they have 2 or more dogs entered. In such a case they must have an additions handler for each extra dog for judging of the group exercises. No dogs shall be entered in Open A and Open B at any one trial.
Utility "A"	The Utility A class is for any dog who has earned a title of C.D.X in Canada but not the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch. Title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or member of their immediate family. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

Utility "B"	The Utility B Class is for any dog that has earned the title of C.D.X or U.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B at any one trial.

Rally Novice "A"	Dogs entered in this class must not have earned their R.N title or any other CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or any member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog shall be entered in Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B as any one trial.
Rally Novice "B"	Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class has been earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may handle more than one dog in this class.
Rally Intermediate	The Rally Intermediate class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement of the Rally Advanced class. This class shall be for any dog who have earned their R.N. title. A Dog completing their R.I. or any other obedience or rally title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Rally Advanced "A"	This class is for dogs that have earned the R.N. title but have not earned the R.A. title or any other CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible for this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.
Rally Advanced "B"	This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Rally Excellent "A"	This class is for dogs that have earned the R.A. title but have not earned the R.E. title or any other CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible for this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.
Rally Excellent "B"	This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

No Entry Will Be Accepted Without Payment in Full. Tendering of a dishonored cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.) Any dishonored cheque or declined credit card(s) will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Entries sent by Greyhound must be sent prepaid;

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but **written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time.** If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial. The Alberta Kennel Club will refund entry, recording and listing fees if the above conditions are met.

A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a Veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

- All reservations must be submitted online or by mail. No telephone reservations will be accepted.
- Spaces are assigned on a first come-first serve basis and may be altered by the Alberta Kennel Club.
- We have a limited number of spaces/electrical drops available for prepaid reserved benching.
- If you wish to bench with a friend, please have one person book all spots.
- No changes will be made once reserved, or at the Show!
- Any Reserved Benching remaining unoccupied by noon on Saturday will be made available for use by other exhibitors.
- Power is for sale ONLY with a reserved benching spot.

POWER: \$90 (Prepaid only)

Is ONLY available with a pre-booked benching space, and MUST be booked at time of ordering reserved benching and by the SAME person.

****Very limited Power Available the day of setup - \$100 - Cash Only ****

Adequate unreserved spaces will be available as per the Benching Map on the day of set-up. No X-pens will be permitted in these spaces

Guidelines for Reserved/Unreserved Benching

- Benching is offered and designed for the convenience of all exhibitors.
- Spruce Meadows does not permit alcohol to be brought into the show building because of pre-existing sponsorship agreements. This prohibition will be enforced and failure to comply may result in forfeiture.
- Any dogs left overnight, are the express responsibility of the exhibitor/agent. Contact information must be present in the set-up and clearly visible. The Alberta Kennel Club assumes no liability in this regard.
- All crates, equipment, chairs, etc. must remain within the limits of designated space.
- Plastic (Not provided by the Alberta Kennel Club) must be used under and up the sides of all exercise pens. Please plan accordingly; this will be strictly monitored for compliance.
- · Exhibitors are expected to keep their space clean and to leave their benching area clean when leaving the show
- Fire Lanes/Aisles must be kept clear.
- All dogs must be exercised in the exercise pens provided for that purpose. Exhibitors are liable for all costs related
 to cleaning or damage caused by a dog (s) under their control. Failure to exercise appropriate diligence may results
 is a loss of show privileges.
- No commercial activity may occur within any space without the express permission of the Alberta Kennel Club Show Chairperson. Exhibitors are welcome to have signage on pens or crates indicating which breed they have on display.
- All Dog Show Rules and Regulations of the C.K.C. and the Alberta Kennel Club will apply to the Reserved Benching areas. Exhibitors will be expected to accept space as assigned and keep it clean or this privilege may be revoked.
- On Sunday January 24, 2016 the space must by vacated within 1 hour following Best in Show.

Any Reserved Benching remaining unoccupied by noon on Saturday will be made available for use by other exhibitors.

Power is ONLY available with a pre-booked benching space, and MUST be booked at time of ordering reserved benching and by the SAME person.

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section

8.2.5 An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- a) registered with the CKC,
- b) have an Event Registration Number,
- c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d) if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- b) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- c) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- d) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8 4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs. Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules.

Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided because

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an allbreed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number.
- (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show. When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (19.7)

A ramp will be available for use at the Judge's discretion.

<u>ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS –</u> EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration</u>

Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature).
