SHOW ETIQUETTE

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (**Conformation Show Rules and Regulations 4.1.5.**)

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You."

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy*A dog between 4 & 6 months on the day of the show.

Junior PuppyA dog between 6 & 9 months on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy.....A dog between 9 & 12 months on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MonthsA dog between 12 & 18 months on the day of the show. Canadian BredA dog which is born in Canada. No champions of any country

Bred by Exhibitor....The handler of the dog is also the breeder and owner.

Open ClassAll dogs.

Specials OnlyCanadian Champion dogs only.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Official: Pre-novice, Novice A, B & C, Novice Intermediate, Open HA, 18A, HB and 18B, Utility A & B.

Note: Pre-Novice, Novice C, and Novice Intermediate classes are not eligible for High in Trial.

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights

Pre-Novice for all dogs over 6 months of age. (Not eligible for HIT Competition)

"A" Classes for dogs handled by the owner or immediate family member through all exercises.

"B" Classes for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh. degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.

"C" Classes for dogs who have completed a C.D. title in Canada.(Not eligible for H.I.T.competition)

C.D.I. Class Novice -Intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada (Not eligible for H.I.T. Competition)

Open

(HA and 18A) No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial. (HA & 18A) For dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co owner or a member

- of the immediate family
- (HB & 18B) For dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in either the Open HB or Open 18B class. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility class are also eligible for entry in one of these classes.
- Utility A For dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D.in Canada.
- Utility B For dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada.
- Exhibition Dogs 6 months & over, not in competition.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

- Novice A For dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and are handled by the owner or immediate family member.
- Novice B For any dog until a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.
- Intermediate For dogs that have earned the RN title.
- Advanced A For dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and are handled by the owner or immediate family member.
- Advanced B For any dog that has earned the RN title.
- Excellent A For dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and are handled by the owner or immediate family member.
- Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title.
- Master For any dog that has earned the RE title.

A Bitch in season **may not** compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded **ONLY** if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian's Certificate.

Junior Handling - Conformation

Best Over Junior - Prize & Rosette
1st through 4th in each competitive class - Ribbon
All other entries receive a participant ribbon. All Pee Wee
handlers will receive a monetary prize.
All dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes or
Exhibition Only on the day of the competition.

Class Structure- Conformation

Pee wee Handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year. This is a non-competitive class.

Junior Novice Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open Level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Senior Novice Handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places with competition, in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Best overall is optional at the discretion of the host club. Junior handlers are eligible to compete in the above class structure from their seventh birthday until they reach their eighteenth birthday.



TROPHIES & AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded for BOB, BOS, BOW BPIB in the limited breed show.

Through the generosity of our sponsors and the friends and members of the Conception Bay A rosette will be offered for Best In Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Baby Puppy in Show, All Group placements, Best Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Group each day and High in Trial in each of the Obedience Trials. Rosettes will be awarded for first place in each of the Rally-O classes

The Conception Bay Kennel Club is pleased to offer a cash prize of **\$500 CDN** for Best in Show at each of the 5 All-Breed shows.

- Suitable prizes will be offered for Group First awards.

Best of Breed in each of the two heritage breeds will receive a work of art by a local artist. BOS, BOW and BPIB will be awarded suitable prizes.

Sue McDermid will partially sponsor BOB in Labrador Retrievers on Saturday, August 13th, under judge Michael Woods. In addition she will donate a vintage, shot over wood duck decoy for the Labrador Retriever with a working/ field designation (WC, JH, SH, MH) that accumulates the highest score in the Breed ring (1 point for each dog defeated) over the course of the shows.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Judging will not commence prior to 8:00 am

The show precincts will be a 150-foot (45m) perimeter from the exterior of the rings.

The venue will be locked each evening. Opening and closing times will be posted in the judging schedule.

Limited number of catalogues will be available at the show.

This is an outdoor show with no cover. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own pop-up tents.

No hydro or water hook-ups available.

RVs and Generators are permitted.

Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy

Dogs not entered in these shows will NOT be allowed within the precincts of the show.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CKC rules.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.

In the event of cancellation between the closing date and the opening of the show this show is forced to cancel due to provincial or federal restrictions related to Covid-19, the entry fees will be fully refunded.

Conception Bay Kennel Club and its show officials will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortunes however caused.

REMEMBER TO 'STOOP AND SCOOP'



GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.

TELEPHONE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

It is your responsibility to verify the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date.

The Show Secretary reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.

Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed / emailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and the New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where a conflict arises between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.

In the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified, or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee, no entry fees will be refunded.

To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loudspeaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

Only dogs eligible for registration with CKC may enter this show and trial.

Conception Bay Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entries, subject to CKC rules.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.
