No entries will be accepted by the Show Secretary after closing time and date. This complies with the instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club. There are no refunds on overpayment. Confirmations will be emailed after closing date.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES Pre Novice, Novice A , B, C, Intermediate Novice, Open A and B, Utility A and B.

Other info.

- Crating is available inside the barn and outside on turf. Crates may be left set up for the evening. Note: no security on site.
- The barn is not heated. Come prepared for early spring Okanagan weather.
- Limited camping is available by previous arrangement. Email wcobc@shaw.ca to reserve a spot.
- There is no off leash area at this trial site. However, there is an off leash dog park is within a 5 minute drive.
- 19.6 Any person, either within or outside the judging ring, who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise interfere in any way with the attention, deportment, or performance of a dog under judgement, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers to be in the best interest of the club, or the judge may take summary action.
- 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring
 steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to
 indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any
 infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such
 action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation
 shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
- Non Member Participation Fee \$57.60 + HST

A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

• Classes

Information from the CKC Obedience Rules and Regulations, this list is a summary which is not meant to replace reading of the CKC Obedience Rules & Regulations)

- Regular & Transition Classes:
- Novice A- only 1 dog per handler in this class, and handler must be owner, coowner or
- o immediate family. This class is not for handlers that have attained a CDX on any dog.
- O Novice B- for handlers or dogs who do meet requirements for Novice A, however dogs
- o who have attained a CD must move to Novice C.
- O Novice C This class is for dogs that have attained the Companion Dog or ANY other
- o obedience title. (not included in HIT)
- o Novice Intermediate- for any dogs which have earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion
- Dog Excellent, Utility or any Obedience Trial Championship " (not eligible for HIT)
- O Open A & B- please see NEW Rules and Regulations
- o Utility A & B- please see NEW Rules and Regulations
- o Pre-Novice- for dogs who have not earned a CD title in any county (not included in HIT).
- Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in the obedience or rally trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN)

Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.
