NON-REGULAR and UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES (CKC Rule 12.9.1): (to be judged after the Regular and Non-Regular classes)

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-ow ned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration formand ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC we besite: http://www.ckc.ca To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN formwith a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VSA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the FRN fee
- b) In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may ETTHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number or a Miscellaneous Certification Number.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
