# DENYS JANSSEN Bogotá - Colombia

In 1988 I bought two Labrador Retrievers so that my young sons could also participate in Junior Handling and then started in Pointers in 1991. Since then I have been fortunate enough to have bred and owned several BIS Pointers. Presently I have 4 Labradors and 15 Pointers at home varying in age from 9 months to 12 years!

In 1996 I was approved to judge all Sporting Breeds having started out with Labrador Retrievers and Great Danes, judging Labrador Retriever and Sporting Group Specialty shows between the years 1991 and 1996. I judged several All Breed Regional Shows between 1996 and 2000 and then in 2001 I was approved to judge All Breeds by the F.C.I.

I have been active in the Asociación Club Canino Colombiano for many years holding the position of Show Director for 10 years and Technical Director for 2 years. Presently I am the Show Director for the Asociación Colombiana de Labradors Retrievers y Demás Razas Puras and I am a member of the Pointer Club of America. In April 2012 I had the honour of judging their National Specialty Show in Sacramento, California.

Apart from judging in Colombia, I have judged in the U.S.A., Canada, Australia, Venezuela, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Argentina, Brazil, Panamá, Ecuador, Peru, Jamaica, Thailand, Malaysia, Mexico, Chile, New Zealand, El Salvador and Korea.

In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. #### CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.) Dogs Competing\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Allocated\* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12  $\{C\}$  has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

\*Award of Merit will be made after Best of Breed judging. A specialty club may offer one Award of Merit for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed.



#### **REGULAR CLASSES**

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

BABY PUPPY – 3 months & under 6 months on the day of the show

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12 - 18 MONTH 12 months & under 18 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/coowner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**VETERANS** - open to all dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veterans Male & Female classes will not compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veteran dogs may be neutered or spayed.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. Should a dog entered for Specials Only place in its group at the show then all awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

**STUD DOG & GET** - The name of the Stud Dog must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the dog and two of his progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

**BROOD BITCH & PROGENY** - The name of the Bitch must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the bitch and two of her progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

**BRACE** Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed or neutered

**SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES** Eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

LONG HAIR VARIETY CLASS- All male and female long hair variety will compete together. Dogs entered in this class must be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only to compete in this class

**FIELD DOG** - Dogs must have obtained a CKC Field Test/Trial title or a WAC/WCA Ratings Title or a NAVHDA title and must be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only to compete in this class

### **GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS**

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.

2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.

3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors patrons, or equipment.

4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under C.K.C. rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.

6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. The ring shall not be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.

7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.

8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied with a fee set by CKC which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

9. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring.

10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from completion by action of the Show Committee.

### Juvenile Sweepstakes

This Sweepstakes class is open to all Weimaraners from 3 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth. All dogs MUST also be entered in a regular class or baby puppy class. The first place dog from each class will be brought together to compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner up in Sweepstakes. Classes (divided by sex) will be as follows: 3 – 6 months Male/Female 6-9 months Male/Female 9-12 month Male/Female 12-15 month Male/Female 15-18 month Male/Female

### Prizes

Sweeps – 20% retained by club to cover expenses 80% divided as follows:

 $1^{st}$  in each class – 25% of total entry fees and rosette

 $2^{nd}$  in each class – 20% of total entry fees and rosette

 $3^{rd}$  in each class – 10% of total entry fees and rosette

 $4^{\text{th}}$  in each class – 10% of total entry fees and rosette

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES - 10% of total entry fee and rosette

BEST of OPPOSITE SEX – 5% of total entry fee and rosette

### Veteran Sweepstakes

This Sweepstakes class is open to all Weimaraners seven years of age or over on the day of the specialty, regardless of their place of birth. All dogs entered, must also be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only at this Specialty Show. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete. The first place dog from each class will be brought together to compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner up in Sweepstakes. Classes (divided by sex) will be as follows:

7 to 9 years Male/Female 9 to 11 years Male/Female, 11+ years Male/Female

### Prizes

Sweeps – 20% retained by club to cover expenses 80% divided as follows:  $1^{st}$  in each class – 25% of total entry fees and rosette  $2^{nd}$  in each class – 20% of total entry fees and rosette  $3^{rd}$  in each class – 10% of total entry fees and rosette  $4^{th}$  in each class – 10% of total entry fees and rosette BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES - 10% of total entry fee and rosette BEST of OPPOSITE SEX – 5% of total entry fee and rosette.
