#### **CLASSIFICATION**

The following CKC conformation classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

#### **REGULAR CLASSES:**

Junior Puppy: for dogs 6 mths of age but under 9 mths of age. Senior Puppy: for dogs 9 mths of age but under 12 mths of age

12-18 Months: for dogs 12 mths of age and under 18 mths of age

Canadian Bred: for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open: for all dogs. Open class is divided by coat: Rough and Smooth and by color: red, black, and any other allowed color

<u>Veterans:</u> for all dogs 7 years of age and oldern on the day of the Specialty. Spayed & neutered dogs are allowed. <u>Specials Only:</u> dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class.

Exhibition Only: for all dogs over 6 mths of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class). Exhibition Only 3-6 Mths: for all dogs 3 months to 6 months of age on the day of the Specialty. Entry in Sweepstakes from this class is allowed.

#### **NON REGULAR CLASSES:**

Baby Puppy (3-6 Mths): For dogs 3 mths of age & under 6 mths of age. Dogs in this class compete for Best Baby Puppy Male and Female and Best Baby Puppy in Specialty.

<u>Sire & Get:</u> for a stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

Dam & Progeny: for a dam and 2 or more of her progeny. Same rules as Sire & Get.

Brace: for 2 dogs of the same breed, not necessarily of the same sex and not necessarily by the same owner. Judged as an identical pair – same color, size, gait, and same stride. Must be handled by one person on one lead.

#### **UNOFFICIAL CLASSES**

All entrants in this Specialty may enter the Head Class and Gait Class. Dogs not entered in a regular specialty class may enter through the Exhibition Only class. Head Class: open to any entrant

Gait Class: open to any entrant

#### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female:

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners.
