IMPORTANT CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION

The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with the CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. For a membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC services and forms online. The non-member participation fees paid in the calendar year (January to December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the club giving the show to see that a judge, official, volunteer, or any participation at an event is not subject to indignities.
- Scent Detection Levels Offered Instinct, Novice (containers, interior, exterior), Open (containers, interior, exterior) and Excellent (container, interior, exterior). Exhibitors can only complete in each class with 1 dog, resets will not be offered.
 - Note: effective July 1, 2021 once a dog has qualified in a component at one class, they may
 move up to the same component in the next class (example: a dog qualifies in Novice container
 may move to Open container) (see CKC Scent Detection Rule 10.1.11)
- Move ups if a qualifying score is earned in a component on Saturday, a move up can be requested for Sunday, prior to end of trial on Saturday if space and time permits. No same day move ups will be allowed.
- Bitches in season bitches in season are not permitted to compete (see CKC Scent Detection Rule). We
 will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of
 a veterinarian's certificate. The certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the
 trial commences.
- Mixed and unrecognized breeds will be accepted at this trial. These dogs must have a CCN (Canine Companion Number) issued by the Canadian Kennel Club in order to participate in these trials. https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Exhibitors/Canine-Companion-Number-Application
- Penalties issued by the club Dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination.
 Contamination of the search area will result in a non-qualifying score and any dog that urinates or
 defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the competition. Handlers will be
 charged for any damage done to equipment by dogs (including urinating on items excessive scratching
 or subsequent breaking of any item).
- **Reminder** anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.
- Indoor kenneling will NOT be available.
