No post dated cheques accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.



All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via The Entry Line. The Club does not accept credit cards for payment. The Entry Line is the only authorized agent for the American Cocker Spaniel Club of Canada

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted

cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

SPECIALTY SHOW FOR AMERICAN COCKER SPANIELS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

<u>Note:</u> Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

COMPETITION FOR SEXUALLY ALTERED DOGS These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy – shall be for puppies 3 up to 6 months old

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Stripped Down Class – for any registered American Cocker Spaniel over 6 months of age. Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum length of 1.5 inches on any portion of the body , with the exception of the ears where no length restrictions apply. Entries will be judged on conformation, first males and then females. WInnerse will then compete for Best Strippd Down. Entrants muist be entered in a regular class or Ex.Only to enter this class.

<u>Note:</u> All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first place in each class as we II as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be two classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 10 years for dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

10 years of age and older for dogs 12 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes

50% remaining of the entry fees for a class will go to the class winners

Junior handling will be offered. Juniors must handle an American Cocker Spaniel

In addition Bobbie was awarded BISS **4 times over**, adding to his winning records he also garnered Group 1 at the **"Nickel Classic"** then topping that off with a Group 1 & Group 2 at the Very Prestigious **"Show of Shows"**.

- The Show & Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The ACSCC and the Halifax Forum will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the
 progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this
 rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The ACSCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the
 dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an
 accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot
 or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the ACSCC and their Show
 Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.
- The precincts of the show shall be the building and the entrances to it..
