Entry Closing Date: October 24, 2018

Dog Eligibility:

- 1. Dogs must be six months of age or older.
- 2. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs may participate.
- 3. Bitches in heat may take part in tests, but must wait until all other dogs have participated.
- 4. Dogs must be sound and in good health. Any dog which appears to be unfit will be removed at the tester's discretion; examples are: lameness, injury, illness, advanced pregnancy.
- 5. For the herding instinct test, dogs need not have had prior herding training, but should have had training to come reliably when called and to down, sit or standstay. It is highly recommended that dogs have had prior supervised exposure to livestock. Owners of participating dogs need not be members of any club or organization.
- 6. A dog owned by the tester or any member of the tester's immediate family or household may not be evaluated by that tester, nor may a dog be evaluated by a tester who has been the owner or the primary trainer/handler of the dog within the last six months.
- 7. Dogs which have been in previous tests and have not passed shall be eligible to be tested again.


Rules/Guidelines:

- 1. We will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to dogs, exhibitors or property
- 2. Welfare of sheep will be foremost: unruly dogs that pose a danger to the sheep will be excused at the discretion of the tester.
- 3. Dogs must be kept under control at all times, and must be kept on leash or crated, at all times except when competing.
- 4. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs
- 5. Bring a chair. You may wish to bring water for your dog.
- DO NOT go into any areas that are marked with "DO NOT ENTER" signs or caution tape. This is a farm and there are areas that are off limits for your safety as well as the safety of our farm animals.

Directions To Tee Creek from Toronto: (via QEW)

Waiver Agreement

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this Herding Instinct Test/clinic and of the opportunity to have the dog assessed, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or test secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises (Tee Creek Dog Training) and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding test/clinic premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to fold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

In the case of injury to any sheep resulting from my (our) dog's actions whether willful or accidental I (we) agree to pay all Veterinary fees, up to and including the market value of \$200.00 per sheep.

I (we)agree to pay the cost of supplies and labour to repair any damage to fences/gates/ equipment which occurs as a result of the actions, either direct or indirect, of me and/or my dog(s), whether wilful or accidental.

I/we also understand that in order to be allowed to participate and use any animal in this/ these events, I/we understand and agree to be responsible for injury or damage caused by me or my dog(s). I/we also understand and accept any and all risks associated with this/these events including, but not limited to, falls, contacts with livestock, the effects of weather and any other potentially hazardous conditions associated with the event site.
