GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Obedience & Rally Obedience Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME.**
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club. IF TRIALS ARE CANCELLED DUE TO COVID, ENTRANTS WILL HAVE A CHOICE OF EITHER A REFUND OF PARTIAL FEES LESS APPLICABLE CREDIT CARD AND DOGSHOW.CA FEES OR THE FUNDS CAN BE HELD OVER IN ENTIRETY FOR NEXT CARIBOO KENNEL CLUB TRIALS.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The Club has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these Shows/Trials, including spectators. NO COMPLAINTS OR ABUSE OF ANY OTHER PERSONS DUE TO COVID REQUIREMENTS WILL BE TOLERATED!

COVID RULES AND INFORMATION

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTERING THESE TRIALS!

By submitting entries to this show you are declaring that you agree to the following strictly enforced rules and regulations. Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not respecting what we must do to abide by the BC Government Covid-19 protocols to keep us all safe.

- 1. Execution of the trial is contingent on the Williams Lake, area of BC moving forward COVID reopening plan that we are allowed to compete in the numbers expressed in the catalogue. Unfettered provincial, interprovincial and international travel is not a prerequisite for operating the show, and refunds will not be considered if you cannot travel to the show due to a restriction on travel.
- 2. MASKS must be worn in the ring and at ring side. Face shields, neck warmers, masks with exhalation valves, handkerchiefs and any other loose fitting contraption are NOT masks. If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you.
- 3. PARKING: There will be limited camp spots please contact Darlene Borrow 1747 Chimney lake Rd. Williams Lake V2G4W2 Ph#250-392-5397
- 4. Violation of any rule may result in your entries for the weekend being cancelled with NO refund of entries.
- 5. Maintain SOCIAL DISTANCING. The venue is huge without the benching. This should not be a problem. We are providing extra space in the rings to maintain these distances.
- 6. Exhibitors should arrive on the grounds **ONE HALF HOUR before their scheduled trial time**
- 7. REFUND POLICY: If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any BC Government, City of Williams Lake or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies or directives, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be considered. In the event of any refunds; credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded. If you are refused entry because you do not pass the COVID Assessment Tool you will not be given a refund. If the Cariboo Kennel Club postpones the trial until Fall, you will have the option to leave your entry fees to be applied to next trials.
- 8. There will NOT be a PHOTOGRAPHER at this show.

CLASSIFICATION - OBEDIENCE OBEDIENCE:

- <u>PRE-NOVICE</u> shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.
- **NOVICE "A"** No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.
- NOVICE "B" Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada
- **NOVICE "C"** as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation
- **INTERMEDIATE NOVICE** as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation
- **OPEN "HA"** The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized
 - breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- <u>OPEN "18A"</u> -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.
- OPEN "HB" The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- <u>OPEN 18B</u> The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes
- <u>UTILITY "A"</u> For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.
- UTILITY "B" Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.
- <u>VETERANS</u> (Unofficial class)— For any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. Exercises shall be performed and judged as in the novice classes. Dog entered in veterans must also be entered in any regular class or exhibition only. Owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.
- Wild Card Classes: No title is required for entry in any Wild Card class, but any dog entered must be capable of performing the exercises required at the class level in which it is entered. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in these classes. A person may enter more than one dog in any of these classes. 16.5.4 Handlers may use verbal encouragement and praise during exercises in these classes without penalty. Handlers may also use additional commands, but will be penalized accordingly. The Wild Card option: A handler may choose to perform all exercises in a class, in which case all will be scored, or a handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. The handler must inform the judge which exercise will be skipped before begin- 67 ning the exercises. If an exercise is chosen to be skipped, it may not be performed. (For example, a handler may choose to omit the Stand for Examination in Novice, the Group Down in Open or the Directed Jumping in Utility, and receive a perfect score for the exercise.) Wild Card Novice class. Any dog that is capable of performing the Novice class exercises may be entered in the Wild Card Novice class, which will be performed and judged as the regular Novice class. Wild Card Open class. Any dog that is capable of performing the Open class exercises may be entered in the Wild Card Open class, which will be performed and judged as the regular Open A class. Wild Card Utility class. Any dog that is capable of performing the Utility class exercises may be entered in the Wild Card Utility class, which will be performed and judged as the regular Utility A class. Handlers are permitted to encourage and praise their dogs verbally during the performance of all Utility exercises except the signal exercise. WILDCARD SCORES WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR HIGH IN TRIAL OR HIGH IN CLASS.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

- **RALLY NOVICE A:** Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- **RALLY NOVICE B:** Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- RALLY INTERMEDIATE: The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.
- RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- **RALLY ADVANCED B:** This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.
- RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- **RALLY EXCELLENT B:** This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign
- **RALLY MASTER**: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE. A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.. A person may enter more than one dog in this class
 - All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
 - No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.
 - No handler who has exhibited a dog through its C.K.C. Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the
 'A' class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.
