Entry Information

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone & Telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or, cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. ENTRIES CLOSE 8:00 PM WEDNESDAY JULY 9TH
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be emailed/mailed 5. as soon as possible after entries close.
- 6. Tendering of NSF Cheques in payment fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action.

General Information

- 1. The show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Alberta Kennel Club and/or Canadian Cardigan Corgi Club will use due care 2. and diligence for the welfare of dogs & exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of 3. management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for 4. absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 5. The Show precinct's shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges, exhibitors or handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside the rings. This is an outdoor show and very little provision is made for case of inclement weather.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show 12 - 15 MONTH 12 months & under 15 months on the day of the show

15 - 18 MONTH 15 months & under 18 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

VETERANS - open to all dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veterans Male & Female classes will not compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veteran dogs may be neutered or spayed.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. Should a dog entered for Specials Only place in its group at the show then all awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

AWARD OF MERIT This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. One Award of Merit is offered at the discretion of the judge for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITON ONLY 3 - 6 MONTHS - puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades but MAY participate in Sweepstakes

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes. STUD DOG & GET - The name of the Stud Dog must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the dog and two of his progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY - The name of the Bitch must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the bitch and two of her progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

BRACE CLASS.... This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

SEXUALLY ALTERED DOG CLASSES - Eligibility for the Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Additional Championship points may be attainable at the group level. See the CKC Dog Show Rules for details.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident</u> non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"
