EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED"; however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (* EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

REGULAR CLASSES

Baby Puppy	A dog 3 months of age & under 6 months of age on the day of the show
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months and up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior Puppy	A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs which are Canadian Champions.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months of age and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the Regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Champion & Championship Points ~ Chapter 1 Section 1 ~ A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided here under:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculations of Championship Points.**

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non-member of the Canadian Kennel Club.

The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members .

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$25.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that the **full name and address of owners MUST be filled in** and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)

NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found on line at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

4. Judging Schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after closing. The Schedule will also be posted on Canuck Dogs www.canuckdogs.com.
5. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required.
6. Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$10.00 will be considered as a donation to the Fredericton Kennel Club Trophy Fund.
7. The Fredericton Kennel Club will use all care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assure any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
8. NOTE: Chap 8 Section 8 of the CKC Dog Show Rules state: A Judge officiating under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty of the Club holding the show to see that this is effectively carried out.
