Next day move-ups will be allowed. Class Move-up Forms will be available. Please give them to the trial secretary as soon as possible.

Notice to Exhibitors

No refunds except in the case of an injury to a dog or handler or bitches in season. Please notify the trial secretary as soon as possible. **Exhibitors**, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited to, the following:

This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations (as of January 1, 2009) and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression. The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.

This is a two ring trial. Rings will run alternately.

No leads, collar, food, toys, or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on course; this includes obstacle familiarization.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

All dogs must be kept in their ex pen or crate or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when leaving the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out-of-control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

Directions

From the North: on Highway 97 turn left on Old Vernon Road just before the Kelowna airport. Follow Old Vernon Road east then south to the ball park at 4720 Old Vernon Road. Follow it east, then north until you reach the ball park at 4720 Old Vernon Road.
