Note: There will be no refunds for duplicate entries or overpayment of fees.

It is the owner of the Pug entered that is responsible for any error in entering his/her Pug regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Please review email confirmations so corrections may be made **prior to closing date** to avoid disappointment.

- 8.6.1 The authorities of any show may decline to accept entries for just cause.
- 4.1.5 No person may approach a judge wither directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within14 days of the action.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - Pugs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - Pugs 9 months of age and under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTHS CLASS- Pugs 12 months of age and under 18 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS- This class shall be for any Pug born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - Pugs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-owner of the Pug. The owner/breeder must handle the Pug in this class, but need not handle the Pug for further awards.

OPEN CLASS - All Pugs

VETERANS CLASS - Pugs 7 years of age or over on the day of the show. Pugs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS. The winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class will go directly onto the Best of Breed competition. (Note: Spayed or neutered Pugs may be entered in this class), divided 7 to under 10 years and 10+ years

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - Pugs that have a recorded CKC Registration or ERN and have attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A TCN Pug may be moved to Specials Only class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or ERN was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class Pug to the Specials Only Class must be received by the Show Secretary one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the Pug is being moved up to. TCN fees will not be refunded.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

CANADIAN BRED BREEDER/OWNER/HANDLER - This class is for Canadian Bred Pugs, born in Canada, that have not yet earned their Championship title (Specials are excluded). The owner/breeder or the breeder/co-owner must handle the pug in this class. Pugs must be entered in a Regular Class and handled by the owner/breeder or the breeder/co-owner in the Regular Class ring to be eligible to enter the CDN BRED BOH in Specialty. There is no entry fee but you must enter this class separately online or check the box on the entry form provided for mailed in entries. No exceptions.

BABY PUPPY - Pugs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show

EXHIBITION ONLY - CATALOGUE listing only. No Pugs entered in this class can compete for any regular classes, however may be entered in and compete in any non-regular classes

BRACE - This class shall be for 2 Pugs (not necessarily the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. A Brace must be handled by one person on one lead.

STUD DOG & Get - This class shall be comprised of the stud Pug and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud Pug may be neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class

BROOD BITCH & Progeny - This class shall be comprised of the dam and 2 or more of her progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The dam may be spayed and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class

2. ENTER ONLINE



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

ALL Entries **MUST** be received by closing date: **WEDNESDAY**, **March 22**nd, **2023** @ **9:00pm Pacific Time**

The tendering of NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by returned cheque. Exhibitors whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted.

Attention foreign exhibitors, please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds.

BORDER CROSSING

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. (30 days prior)

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from:

CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9 or online at www.ckc.ca

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$115 plus GST (for Canadian residents) (\$230 non-resident), which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

HERITAGE PARK FIRE SAFETY RULES:

Extension cord may not be stretched across fire lanes.

Tape of any kind is not to be used on the floors.

All power cords must be unplugged at night.

Aisles must be kept open at all times to allow everyone easy and speedy exit in case of emergency. All designated FIRE LANES must be kept clear at all times or vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.

ADDITIONAL CLUB RULES:

Only dogs entered will be allowed in the building.

Grooming area is for dogs entered only.

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Violators will be asked to leave the show grounds.

Crates will be allowed at ringside during the judging of your specific breed only and must be removed immediately after. No Exceptions.

Dogs are not allowed in washrooms.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you will exercise control and restraint over the children in your care on the days of these shows.

The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or venders/concessions.

The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.

Delays waiting for dogs are not possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their dogs "conflict".

The club reserves the right of restricting exhibitors grooming space.

Plastic sheeting must be under all ex-pens.

Any tape used in the building has to be easily removable and must be removed after the show is completed. Coloured tape/duct tape and/or Gorialla Tape is not allowed. You must leave your setup in the same clean condition you found it in when you first arrived at the show.

Unless permission is granted in writing by the Mount Cheam Canine Association, there will not be any handling classes operated or offered by anyone in any part of the Heritage Park facility at any time. Power bars are not permitted as they will blow fuses.

No paper from under the ex-pens or crates or liquid waste are to be disposed of in garbage cans. They must go in the bins provided outside the building. Anyone putting any dog papers or waste into garbage containers on floor one will not be permitted to enter future shows as Heritage Park may refuse to have dog events if this continues.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	Ο	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed here under.

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) and have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain a minimum of 20 points which must include a minimum of two wins of at least 2 points and at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.
- (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.
- 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.
- (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.
- (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) (48-06-12)
- 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.
- 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:
- (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)
- (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.
- (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.
- 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.
- 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.
- 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Renaissance Dog Association, the Pug Club of Canada, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any

other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
