Location: The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds owned by Kim and Lindsey Good. A map showing the location of the grounds will be provided to entrants at the time the running order is distributed. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet.

General Information:

- Courses and Birds Partridge, Quail and/or pheasant will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. There will not be a bird field. Three birds will be released for the first dog tested and two birds per do thereafter. In FDX 5 birds will be released for the first brace and two birds per dog thereafter. The BSCC reserves the right in case of bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- **Horses on the course** Bird planters, marshals and judges may use horses. All other participants and spectators must be on foot. **All dogs will be handled on foot.**
- **Clothing -** All persons on the course in FD, FDA and FDX must wear a blaze orange garment, a hat alone will not be allowed. If you do not have one, items will be provided.
- Gallery a gallery of spectators may be permitted (**following all COVID rules**). This will be at the discretion of the judges and handlers. Spectators in FD, FDA and FDX must remain together at all times and shall follow the directions of the judges, marshal and gunners. All other spectators must remain in the camp area.
- Entries Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in approximately eight (8) hours of judging time.

- Starting times will be announced (earliest start will be 8 a.m.) running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn
- Firearms Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA and FDX shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by official gunners only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired – please provide your own starting pistol.
- In Season Bitches Bitches in season will not be permitted to run.
- **Collaring** collaring of a dog is allowed with the permission of the judge
- Tracking Collars The BSCC is allowing the use of electronic tracking collars in this Test. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. Participants must declare that they are using the tracking collars to the Field Test chairman and also to the judges. NOTE: as per rule 11.1 (c) viii With the exception of tracking collars, Dogs may also wear one flea and tick collar in addition to the other two collars. The flea and tick collar must not be modified and must be used as it is received from the manufacturer. All collars shall be worn around the dog's neck.
- Training or exercising training or exercising of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday evening until completion of judging on Sunday).
- Smoking is prohibited except in your parked vehicles. NO OPEN FIRES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- **Food** There will be no hospitality available.

- Prizes Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test no ribbons will be mailed. Due to COVID 19 we will attempt to provide scores and ribbons as quickly as possible after each run, allowing participants to depart the grounds after running their dog.
- Rules All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of the Premium List. This listing fee is \$10.50 per dog per each event entered during the field Test and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries for this Field Test are accepted on condition that the BSCC, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

COVID 19

Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic the club will be adhering to all recommended guidelines in the Province of Alberta. Since this is an outdoor event masks will not be mandatory but please respect the physical distancing guidelines and other people's space. We highly recommend showing up running your dog and leaving.

General guidelines to consider:

- 1. Practice physical distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- 2. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others. The Club will provide masks if desired for officials, judges and volunteers
- 3. Wash hands as frequently as possible. We will have disinfecting spray and or wipes at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
- 4. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- 5. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Things to remember:

- 1. There will be no hospitality available (thanks COVID-19).
- 2. Bring water and food for yourself and your dogs. Blaze orange vest & hat, mosquito spray, starter pistol etc.
- 3. The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the Test grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicle.
- 4. If your dog poops, please scoop and dispose in the provided garbage bags or consider packing out your own refuge.
