DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES:

Day of trial entries will be accepted as space allows and must be submitted 1 HOUR prior to your ring time. Day of entries shall be \$40.00 per entry. Move ups within the same trial ie: Novice to Open are not permitted. A prize and ribbon are not guaranteed for day of entries, however any ribbons earned will be sent out post-trial if required.

VENUE:

These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the trial. Remember that this is a public facility and a place of business. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event.

WASHROOM FACILITIES: Facilities are available indoors.

CKC REGULATION:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.”

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the C Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or available to view with the Event Secretary.
