Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel</u> <u>Document.</u>

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

In order to compete in the any Non-Regular or Unofficial classes, dogs must also be entered in the regular classes or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial</u> <u>classes or Parades</u>
BRACE	For two dogs, not necessarily owned by the same person.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.
3-GENERATIONS CLASS	Consists of three dogs in a three generation DIRECT line (i.e., Mother or Father with son or daughter and grandson or granddaughter or great grandson or great granddaughter). These dogs are shown together (handled separately). To be judged on similarity of type (similar to stud dog or brood bitch). Dogs may be spayed/neutered and breeder(s) owner(s) need not be identical.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24.12.3)

 a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$57.60 + 5% GST.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

Attention All Foreign Exhibitors

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require</u> an **ERN** - **Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST**. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.
