COVID – 19 Event Safety Plan

The North Saanich Dog Obedience Training Club welcomes back our participants for our trials on April 16 & 17 2022. Only people who show proof of two vaccinations done two weeks before the event date will be allowed to pick up their armbands and wristbands. Wristbands are put on the wrist when issued and cannot be removed while in the building.

<u>Rules</u>

This event will follow all recommendations by the PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICER of BC and may be subject to change, go to our <u>FACEBOOK Page</u> for updates.

These rules will be posted at all entrances.

- By order of the PHO, proof of two vaccinations will be required to all people born in 2009 or earlier (12+).
- Only people with wristbands will be allowed in the building.
- All participants will use hand sanitizer when entering the building.
- Social distancing rules must always be followed.
- Masks must be worn inside the building.
- Participants are permitted to bring crates in the building but must ensure adequate space for social distancing for all exhibitors. No dogs can be left in the building overnight.

People refusing to comply with the safety plan will be asked to leave the show grounds and will not receive a refund for entries. Please have patience with all volunteers, as they are working hard to provide a safe and fun environment. Abuse of volunteers and other exhibitors will not be tolerated.

JUDGING SCHEDULES Judging will not commence prior to 9:00 AM Local Time. Detailed Judging Schedules will be sent to entrants after the closing date. Every effort will be made to avoid conflicts between the trials and to accommodate entrants from the Mainland and Up Island.

RULES AND REGULATIONS, It is the responsibility of each competitor to be familiar with and abide by the Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trial & Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2021.

FEMALES IN SEASON When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, entry and TCN fees will be refunded provided that a veterinarian's certificate certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial is received by the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial.

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

DISCIPLINE (20.7) It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a trial held under the CKC Obedience and Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CLASSIFICATION - RALLY OBEDIENCE

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

<u>RALLY NOVICE B</u> - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

RALLY INTERMEDIATE – The Rally Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Rally Advanced classes. This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RI or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs may be entered in this class as a regular entry or changed to it from another official class within the same trial. The request to change must be made on the appropriate CKC form and be submitted to the trial secretary at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the trial.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RN title but have not earned the RA title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

<u>RALLY ADVANCED B</u> - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RA title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RA title but have not earned the RE title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RA title. A dog completing the RE title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

<u>RALLY MASTER</u> - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RE title. A dog completing the RM title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

CLASSIFICATION – OBEDIENCE

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> - The Pre-Novice class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of PCD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all five exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of CD may enter the Pre-Novice class.

NOVICE A - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under Section 10.1.4. No person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

NOVICE B - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

NOVICE C - The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

OPEN HA & OPEN 18A - The Open A classes shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD but has not earned the title of CDX. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in these classes and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person

who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle a dog in these classes. When a dog is wrongfully entered in these classes, any score awarded will be cancelled. No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial.

OPEN HB & OPEN 18B - The Open B classes shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD. Dogs that have earned the title of CDX or any higher obedience titles may enter either of the Open B classes. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. Dogs in these classes may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in these classes. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such case, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise(s). Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed for Open HB and Open 18B. These choices will not be disclosed to exhibitors until they are posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of each class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines, so they will be used approximately the same number of times. No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial.

<u>UTILITY A -</u> The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX but has not earned the title of UD. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY B</u> - The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX or UD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial.

EXHIBITION ONLY - This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only, which is an official class that must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any regular class; however, it may be entered in and compete in any unofficial class or parade offered at the trial on payment of the prescribed fees.

TCN fee (per show/per dog) \$ 10.50. TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). Effective March 2nd, 2021, all owners of unregistered CKC-recognized breeds, entering events are required to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). <u>TCN instructions.</u>

<u>CLASSES</u> The following CLASSES will be offered in each trial. Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries. OBEDIENCE – Pre-Novice, Novice A, B & C, Novice Intermediate, Open HA & HB, Open 18A & 18B, Utility A & B, and Exhibition. RALLY – Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Master and Exhibition.

THE PRECINCTS OF THESE SHOWS ARE ALL AREAS RESERVED for the North Saanich Dog Obedience Training Club and include the RCMP Building and the parking lots on the Saanich Fairgrounds.

RULES GOVERNING ALL TRIALS

1. Dogs must always be kept under control at all times and on leash within the building with the exception of the Obedience and Rally ring. No dogs will be allowed inside the RCMP Building during the trials unless officially entered in the trials except for Certified Assistance Dogs.

2. Collars other than those specified in these rules are not allowed within the venue. Violation of this rule may result in removal of the dog from further competition at the trial.

3. The North Saanich Dog Obedience Training Club will use all reasonable care to ensure the safety of the dogs exhibited but will not be responsible for or assume any liability for loss or injury to any dog or exhibitor. If for any reason beyond the control of the club it is impossible to open or complete the trials no refund of entry fees will be made.

4. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with their dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called.

5. Any dog entered and received at an obedience trial must compete in all individual exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, superintendent, or the trial chair.

6. Eligibility to enter specific classes is detailed in the Obedience Trial & Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations. Entrants should review these requirements before entering the trials to ensure they are entered in the correct class. NOSA will not be held responsible for incorrect entries.

7. Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration or Performance Event number; be eligible for registration with the CKC; have a Miscellaneous Certification number if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or, have a Canine Companion Number if a mixed or unrecognized breed.

8. Please keep the building and grounds clean. Please pick up after your dog - an exercise area and cleanup materials will be provided.

9. Except for HIC and HIT trophies, exhibitors must ask the show secretary for the **"Trophy Eligibility Sign Up Sheet."** Exhibitors must sign up and indicate what trophy they are eligible for before they participate. The exhibitor or a representative must be present when prizes are awarded – NOSA will not take responsibility to deliver trophies. All awards (except High in Class) will be given out at the end of each trial. All prizes will be awarded for qualifying scores only.

The VENUE and PRECINCTS of these trials will be the RCMP Building.
