Listing fees are payable with the entry fee for dogs that do not have their Individual registration number at closing date. A litter registration is not acceptable. Official CKC entry forms must be used. Please photo copy the enclosed entry forms if you require more than were supplied.

Personal cheque or Money order for the full amount only will be accepted and should be made out to **EVANGELINE KENNEL CLUB**.

No post dated cheques accepted. The Shows and Trials Division of the CKC interprets the term Post Dated to mean date other than the date on which the entry was received. Entries cannot be processed unless the date of the cheque is current. All NSF cheques & declined credit cards will be subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards . All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The precincts of the shows and trials will be the buildings & its entrances..

The building will be open at 7:00 am. Saturday & Sunday and Friday evening until 8pm for early setup.

A canteen will be available and breakfast will be served.

The Evangeline Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

In the event of acts of God or nature the show has to be cancelled, no refunds will be given.

Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.

The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.

Champions and championship points - chapter 21

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded winners also places in the group.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.
