

Entries will be accepted until the time of the draw at 8:00pm, Wednesday, September 17, 2025. The draw will be held at the home of the Field Trial Secretary. Starting dog in the Junior and Qualifying will be determined by the draw. Starting dog for the Amateur will be determined by the TSX closing number on Thursday, September 25, 2025. A system of rotation may be used for all stakes.

- Signed original and entry fees must be delivered within one hour of the commencement of the trial.
- **NEW**For dogs without a permanent CKC or ERN registration number, a <u>Temporary Competition Number (TCN)</u> must be applied for (online, paper application, or contact Show & Trials Division CKC 1-855-364-7252), BEFORE SUBMITTING AN ENTRY FEE FOR AN EVENT. The same TCN must be used for all event entries until the dog is permanently registered.
- Entry Forms must be completed in full and accompanied by ENTRY FEES AND, if applicable, \$10.50 Temporary
 Competition Fee.
- Please Note CKC Ruling: Canadian Resident non CKC Members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement towards awards unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial or all awards will be cancelled.
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulation 21.7: In summary, it provides that any Person participating in a Trial shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind. Violations of this rule shall be dealt with in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.
- Males and Females will be run in the order of the draw. Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn.
- Any dog not appearing within 15 minutes of its time to run may be disqualified.
- Dead ducks, pheasants, or other game birds will be used in all stakes.
- Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded. Placement prizes may include merchandise or sponsor contributions of merchandise.
- No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS:

By entering this Trial each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the Trial and agrees to release and save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the Trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death. Other refunds (less a scratch fee of \$10.00 per dog) may be given for good cause at the discretion of the field trial committee. All requests for refunds must be in writing and must be received within 2 days of the last day of the trial and, unless otherwise agreed by the field trial committee, must be accompanied by a Veterinarian's certificate.

Our thanks to all who have contributed to the success of this trial, and particularly the landowners on whose land this trial is being held. Please show your appreciation by leaving the area clean. There will be no training on the grounds after Thursday, September 26. Please follow the posted signage.




