Cost: \$450/working spot - Limited to 8 dogs Auditing - \$75/day - \$100/both \$200.00 deposit required to hold a spot, with the remainder due before July 1, 2018.

Clinic Information: The clinic will be held on sheep, ducks may be also be available. CKC regulation sized arenas and a round pen will be utilized to accommodate dogs and handlers of all levels. The clinic includes lunch each day and refreshments will be available throughout the day.

There is free on site camping, sorry no hook ups. Some pet friendly hotels that are close by check out www.expedia.ca for more options and rates.

There will be NO refunds for cancellations unless the spot can be filled by someone on a waitlist (does not apply for auditors). If you have a spot and sell it to another, please let us know. There is no discount for multiple dogs, switching dogs during clinic is not permitted unless cleared by the clinic host & clinician, and may incur an additional fee.

There is a STRICT stoop N scoop policy. ALL dogs must be on leash, crated or x-penned at all times when not being instructed. An off-leash area with a swimming hole and trails will be available and accessible after the clinic ends for the day.

How to find Sheep Thrills Farm: You can find us on Google maps. There is also a map on our website, http://www.sheepthrills.ca however we're pretty easy to find. We are located about 15 minutes from Saskatoon. To get here, head west on 22nd Street on Hwy 14. At the Sandridge gas station, turn left (south) onto Young Road (Google maps incorrectly calls it Chappel Road). Go down 1 mile to the stop sign, then turn right (west) onto the paved road. Go about a mile, we are the last place on the right hand side just before the train tracks.
