Dogs **MUST** be entered in the show, or for Exhibition Only, to be on the show grounds. CKC Show Rules require that the precincts must consist of all areas of the facility reserved for the use of the Club, exclusive of the parking area. Dogs that are not entered in this show, including puppies under 4 months of age, are not permitted within the show's precincts, including in the commercial booth area. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated area only.

- \*Crates are permitted at RINGSIDE only during the judging of your breed.
- \*Dogs left in the building overnight are understood to be left at the owner's/agent's own risk.
- \*Any vehicle parking in the handicapped designated area must display handicapped authorization.

#### **Temporary Competition Numbers**

All dogs entered in CKC events that are not CKC registered must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering into the event(s). This includes Baby Puppies in Conformation shows. Please note that Listed Breeds are not eligible for a TCN (effective July 6, 2021, this includes Baby Puppies). Listed Breeds must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entering into an event. The Conformation Show Rules will be updated in this regard.

#### Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

#### EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

- **4.7.1** A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty, and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out
- **19.7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this copy of this regulation shall be prom inently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

#### **Show Officials 5.1.6**

The officials of a show-giving club will be held responsible for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

#### **ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3**

Entry forms received by the CKC that are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

#### **ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5**

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

#### **ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1**

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

#### **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2**

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. (58-06-17) (58-06-17) (13-09-17) 48 A dog disqualified under Section 14.1.2 (b) is not eligible for reinstatement

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

#### **Regular Classes:**

**JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS** – for dogs 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show.

**SENIOR PUPPY CLASS** – for dogs 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show.

**12 to 18 MONTH CLASS** – for dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of the show.

**CANADIAN BRED CLASS** – for dogs born in Canada; Champions in any other country excluded.

**OPEN CLASS** – for all dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY** – This class will not be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible, it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

#### **Unofficial Classes:**

**BABY PUPPY CLASS** – for dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

**EXHIBITION ONLY** – Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:

  (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation rule book are available from the CKC, #400 - 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9.

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC STANDARD TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the show grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators, we insist upon keeping the grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it into the judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, Pandemic or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.
