General Information:

1. The Trial Secretary will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. The Komoka Top Dogs Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of entry will be made.
4. The trial precincts shall be the entire building of Komoka Top Dogs Obedience Club.

Limited Entry:

RALLY: Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour less time for walkthroughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

OBEDIENCE: Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

There is no guarantee that they will be entered immediately into the system, and Komoka Top Dogs will not be held responsible for ensuring timely entry or successful entry into trials. We encourage you to enter directly through The Entry Line.

If entry is done in this manner, payment must be e-transferred to KomokaTopDogs@hotmail.com prior to the entry form being processed. Please use "Komoka" as the answer to your security question. If trial is full upon receipt of payment, funds will not be accepted. No faxed entries or credit cards will be processed.

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Any US entries must be made through **The Entry Line**.

Entry Information:

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone/fax entries are accepted by The Entry Line at 1-800-293-2935; (fax) 519-754-0796. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
4. Identification cards and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Trial Secretary upon arrival at the trial.
5. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$30 service charge.

BEFORE YOU ENTER A RALLY “A” CLASS!

- If the dog you are entering has earned any CKC obedience title other than a PCD (e.g., a CD title or higher), the dog CANNOT be entered in any Rally “A” class.
- Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC CDX title CANNOT enter the “A” classes.
- *Rally Novice A*: Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC RA title CANNOT enter the Novice A class.
- *Rally Advanced A*: Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC RE title CANNOT enter the Advanced A class.
- *Rally Excellent A*: Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC RM title CANNOT enter the Excellent A class.
- ***Entering the wrong class will result in the cancellation of legs and titles.***

Mixed & Unrecognized Breeds:

- These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.
- Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. *A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.*

Bitches in Season:

- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

Moving Up:

- Section 6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.
- Section 6.9.3: The Trial Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.
- Section 6.9.5: In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or an Event Registration Number (ERN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN):

- A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.
- A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a PEN or a CCN number.
- *Note:* There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

Event Registration Number (ERN):

- All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).
- The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Performance Event Number (PEN):

- A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registrable dog of a CKC-RECOGNIZED BREED to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:
 - The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC (*not* on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List).
 - The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration.
 - The dog must be spayed or neutered.
 - The dog must be properly identified with a CKC-approved microchip.
- ***A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.***

Canine Companion Number (CCN):

- A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows UNRECOGNIZED & MIXED BREEDS to compete in CKC performance events.
- To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:
 - The dog must be either a mixed breed or unrecognized breed.
 - Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.
 - Unrecognized breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
 - The dog must be identified with a Canadian Kennel Club approved microchip.
 - No wolf-dog hybrid will be permitted a CKC CCN.
- ***A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.***
All the above 'registration' numbers can be obtained:
 - Online through CKC's Portal; or
 - By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC.

Indignities to a Judge, Official or Exhibitor:

- Section 20.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind.
- The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations:

- The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.
- Section 20.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind.
- The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Master Obedience Trial Champion (MOTCH):

- Section 14.3.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters MOTCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.
- Section 14.3.2 Points for this title may only be accumulated after the completion of the OTCH title.
- Section 14.3.3 Points may be accumulated simultaneously with credits toward both the OTCHX and MOTCH titles. However, the MOTCH title will not be awarded until completion of the OTCHX title.
- Section 14.3.4 One High in Class placement is required in either of the Open B classes or the Utility B class but no minimum score is required.
- Section 14.3.5 A dog must acquire a total of 40 points to earn a MOTCH title. A minimum of 15 points must be obtained from either of the Open B classes and the Utility B class. The remaining 10 points can be obtained from either class.

Rally Champion (RCH)

- Section 16.1: The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.
- Section 16.2: A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.
- Section 16.3: The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial:
 - (a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
 - (b) 50 points must come from the Rally Master class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.

- Section 16.4 A qualifying score must be earned in both the Excellent B class and the Master class in the same trial on five (5) different occasions under at least five (5) different judges

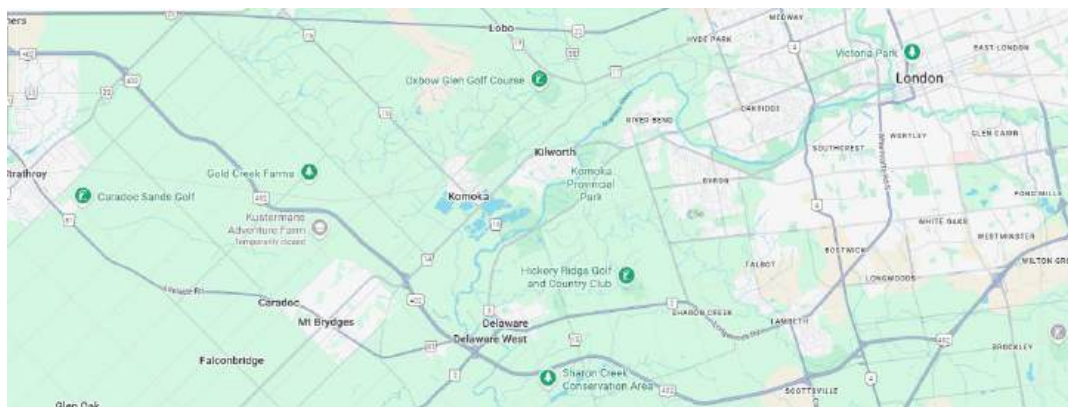
Directions to Show Site:

TOP DOGS TRAINING CLUB 20215 VANNECK ROAD, KOMOKA, ON N0L 1R0

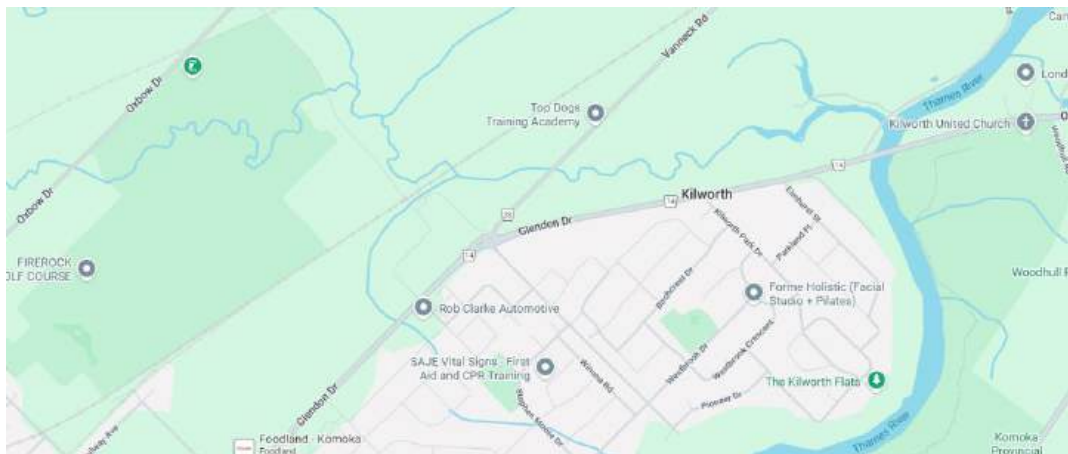
From Toronto: Take 401 west to 402. Use Exit 82 (Cty road 14 Glendon Drive/Komoka/ Mt Brydges). Turn left onto County Road 14 at stop sign. Proceed north through Komoka until you reach the NEW ROUNDABOUT. Use 3rd Exit onto Vanneck Road (County Road 38). Facility is near the top of the hill on your left: 20215 Vanneck Road.

From Windsor: Take 401 East, Exit 157 road 14 Iona Road, Melbourne, Iona. Turn left towards Melbourne on County Road 14. This will change to County Road 9. Proceed through Melbourne. Turn Right onto Glendon Drive (County Rd 14) and pass through Mount Brydges and Komoka until you reach the NEW ROUNDABOUT. Use 3rd Exit onto Vanneck Road (County Road 38). Facility is near the top of the hill on your left: 20215 Vanneck Road. .

From the North: From Gainsborough turn south onto Vanneck Road south to 20215 Vanneck Road. Facility is on your Right as you descend hill.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Exercise your dogs on the grass in front of first green building.
- Remember to clean up after your dogs.
- No indoor crating available at these trials.
- No dogs are allowed past any posted barriers on the property. This is a rented venue -- we do not own the grounds, and all must follow landlord's requests.
- Shoes must be changed prior to entering the ring EVERY TIME.
- Rally trials: In order to keep things moving smoothly and effectively, we ask for the dog next in the ring be ready with shoes changed before the prior dog leaves the ring. The second on deck dog will be asked to enter the building in order to prepare while the other two dogs are still in the building. Directions will be given by volunteers to keep things moving smoothly.
- Obedience trials: In order to keep things moving smoothly and effectively, we ask that you be ready with shoes changed before the prior dog leaves the ring.
