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### CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

**Section 4.7.3** states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

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### MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

**Chapter 8, Section 8.9** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

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**CATALOGUES**

Catalogues are available on a **PRE-ORDER basis only**. Those who wish to pre-order at a price of \$6.00 may do so by indicating this on their entry form. Your catalogue will be waiting for you at the show.

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## TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

***A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN).***

TCNs can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or
- By contacting the Shows & Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252.

***Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.***

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## EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$62.40 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

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## NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

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## ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries close 8 P.M. (EST) Wednesday, September 15, 2021, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.**
5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.**

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## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Burlington Kennel & Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
6. The show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges, exhibitors or handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside the judging rings.

**Award of Merit:** Rosettes will be offered, and will be presented at the completion of Breed judging. One Award of Merit will be offered for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed.

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**SWEEPSTAKES**

The following classes are offered: Baby Puppy (4-6 months), Junior (6-9 months), Senior (9-12 months), 12-18 Months on the day of the specialty.

Classes are divided by sex. First-place winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Regular classes at the specialty.

Rosettes will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes. Ribbons will be awarded to all first through fourth.

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**VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

The following classes are offered: 7-9 years, 9-11 years, and 11 years and over on the day of the specialty. Classes are divided by sex. First-place winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Official classes at the specialty. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

Rosettes will be awarded to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Veteran Sweepstakes for both Puppy and Veterans. Ribbons will be awarded to all first through fourth.

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**SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY**

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows: Best in Sweepstakes will receive 15% of total entry fee. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 10% of total entry fee. First Place winners in each class will divide 50% of the total entry fee. The remaining 25% of total fees will be retained by the club for administration.

The following classes are offered: 7-10 years, and 10 years and over on the day of the specialty. Classes are divided by sex. First-place winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Official classes at the specialty. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

Rosettes will be awarded to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Veteran Sweepstakes for both Puppy and Veterans. Ribbons will be awarded to all first through fourth.

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**SWEEPSTAKES  
PRIZE MONEY**

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows: Best in Sweepstakes will receive 15% of total entry fee. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 10% of total entry fee. First Place winners in each class will divide 50% of the total entry fee. The remaining 25% of total fees will be retained by the club for administration.

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**CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

**Section 15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

**Section 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

**Section 15.1.11** A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

**Section 15.2.1** The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

**15.2.2** Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

**Section 15.2.3** To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated

based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### **Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)**

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

#### **Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)**

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.



- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

**Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)**

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GCHEX POINTS**

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

**Section 15.3.2** To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

**Section 15.3.3** Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

**NOTE:** Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

POINTS**

**Section 13.8.1** Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

## **BURLINGTON KENNEL & OBEDIENCE CLUB COVID-19 PROCEDURES FOR 2021 SHOW**

At the time of this notice (July 28, 2020) the Government of Ontario Health has set guidelines for social gatherings and based on those guidelines the Burlington Kennel & Obedience Club will be a SHOW AND GO prodical.

### **THERE WILL BE NO INDOOR GROOMING!!!**

We ask/encourage exhibitors to bring your own popups/shelter for being outdoors. There is a limited number of electrical outlets on the outside of the show building so we ask that you all share these outlets if needed.

We ask that exhibitors DO NOT ARRIVE on the premises until 90 minutes before their show scheduled time. Once you have finished exhibiting your dog and if you do not move forward in competition you MUST LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES building and grounds to enable us to stay within the health guidelines.

The indoor show area and any other show rings will be MANDATORY MASK WEARING. All exhibitors MUST wear a mask when showing their dogs.

There will not be a show catalogue on the secretary's table. You must provide your show ID and the show secretary will give you your armbands.

Ribbons will be handled by the ring steward only. If you take the ribbon presented please DO NOT return it to the table. We ask that you keep it or not take it at all.

No spectator seating will be allowed around the rings.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.**

Hand sanitizer and hand wipes will be on all tables.

The toilet facilities will be portable toilets and wash stations only. The West Niagara Fair Grounds will not allow the general public the use of the indoor facilities.
