Ribbons / Rosettes: Flat ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying component. New title rosettes will be awarded for any dog completing a title in these trials.

Day of Trial Entries: Day of trial entries will be accepted as space allows and must be submitted prior to the judges briefing. Day of entries shall be \$40.00 per component and only cash will be accepted on the day of the trial. Move-ups within the same trial / day ie: Novice to Open are not permitted. Move-ups for the following trial / day should be into the trial secretary before end of the first day.

Bitches in season- you must notify us so we can move you to the end of the run order



TEST SITE: No indoor kenneling. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test (where off leash searches are permitted). **The use of non-trial odor is NOT permitted on the test site.** Remember that this is a public facility used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event. Stairs during the trial may need to be used to access search areas. Please inform the club if you need assistance. Washroom facilities are available indoors.

CKC REGULATION: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.”
