Telephone entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the Board of Directors of the CKC may otherwise authorize. online entries and/or credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD or AMEX credit card number. Customers' charges that are declined will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date. It is recommended that you phone after you fax your entry to ensure that it was received and readable. All NSF cheques will be subject to a \$45.00 service fee.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

Border Crossing

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned, and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at 416-675-5511 (phone) or 416-675-6506 (fax).

^{**}A TCN Fee of \$10.50 must be paid for any dog not having a CKC individual registration number or ERN.

Conformation Classes

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY- dogs 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY- dogs 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show.

12 TO 15 MONTHS- dogs 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 TO 18 MONTHS- dogs 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED- dogs born in Canada.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR- dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS- all dogs. Class divided by colour: Black and Tan, Blenheim, Ruby, Tri-Colour.

VETERAN- dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Class divided by age. The winner of each class will compete for Best of Breed.

7 TO 9 YEARS / 9 TO 11 YEARS / 11 YEARS AND OLDER

SPECIALS ONLY- A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible, it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a listed dog in this class is NOT allowed.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

BABY PUPPY- 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

STUD DOG & GET- shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY- This class shall have the same requirements as Stud Dog & Get.

BRACE- This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair- same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

ALTERED- This class shall be for neutered or spayed dogs over 6 months of age.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

4 to 6 Month, 6 to 9 months, 9 to 12 months, 12 to 15 months, 15 to 18 months.

2nd, 3rd and 4th place in each class receives ribbon

Winner of each class receives 5% of total entry fees collected and rosette

1st overall in sweeps receives 20% of total entry fees collected and rosette

2nd overall in sweeps receives 10% of total entry fees collected and rosette Club retains 20% to defray costs

To enter Juvenile Sweepstakes the dog must be entered in one of the regular classes on Friday September 3, 2021

2nd overall in sweeps receives 15% of total entry fees collected and rosette

Club retains 25% to defray costs

JUNIOR HANDLING CONFORMATION

Sunday September 5, 2021

At the end of Breed Judging

(All Dogs Must be entered in the Specialty to be used in Juniors)

Junior Handling

Registration will be at the show secretary's table. Complete entries only. Entry deadline will be shown in the judging schedule. Prize and rosette offered for Best Overall and for each placement.

Classes in Junior Conformation Handling competition shall be divided by age as follows: PEE WEE CLASS-This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

JUNIOR NOVICE CLASS- This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition. JUNIOR OPEN CLASS-This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS- This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS- This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

SENIOR NOVICE CLASS- This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

SENIOR OPEN CLASS- This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level

Method of moving between classes shall be as follows: If a handler achieves 6 first place wins with competition, he must move to the Open Class within his age group. Points are to be carried forward from one level to the next.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As Of July 2021 The Rules For Awarding Of Grand Champion And Grand Champion Excellent Have Changed. Please See The CKC Conformation Rule Book 15.2 Grand Champion (Gch) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (Gchex) Rules

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES - SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS - SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the event. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Event Superintendent or the Event Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the event.
- 3. The event committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, show secretary, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a event held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the event and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the event to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the event grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME.**
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these events is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the event Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
