LOCATION: Gableridge German Shepherds and Dog Sports, 342 Mountain View Road, Arnprior, Ontario, Canada K7S 3G9 (45km from W. Ottawa via HWY ON-417W)

JUDGE: Holly Nagel (BHAJ-157A), Tonawanda, NY

- Competitors do not earn qualifying scores towards any Barn Hunt Title when participating in a fun test
- Competitors may enter any level they wish at a Fun Test, and competitors may enter more than one level and or multiple times at the same level
- A Barn Hunt Registration Number is NOT required for a dog to be entered in a Fun Test but participants must be familiar with BHA rules; please visit www.barnhunt.com for the complete rulebook.
- Classes offered: Instinct (\$5/run) Novice, Open, Senior and Master (\$10/run each class)
- Open to ALL breeds/mixed breeds 6 months of age or older
- Entry limit, 6 hours of judging.
- **Entries Open:** October 1, 2018. **Entries Close:** midnight October 24, 2018 or earlier if test fills prior to date.
- Maximum of 5 dog entries per envelope.
- **If Test is not full, Late entries and Day of Show entries will be accepted** from (9am to 10am). Late and Day of show entry fees as follows: Instinct (\$10/run) Novice, Open, Senior and Master (\$15/run each class)
- Building opens at 8:30am. Check in 9:00am to 9:30am. 10am first dog on the line.
- Trial will be held undercover in an unheated building, on dirt/sand. Blind/staging area approx 15' x15' will be adjacent to the building under cover. Crating in vehicle or outside.
- Dogs must be under control (in crate) and/or on leash at all times when not being tested. Crating in vehicle or outside. Lots of Parking on grass is available on site. Participants will be able to erect shade/rain shelters.
- Bitches in season can participate in panties.

Running Order: Gableridge Barn Hunt reserves the right to change the run order based on entries and will send final tentative class run order and judging schedule confirmation prior to the start of the fun test (except for same day entries). Dogs will be run in height order.

Dogs being handled by the same person must be separated into different staged groups.

It is expressly understood that participants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. Any participant whose dog(s) create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Gableridge Barn Hunt Club, Gableridge German Shepherds and Dog Sports and all persons associated with running this event will assume no responsibility for any loss damage or injury sustained by participants or spectators, or to any of their dog's or property.

- Exhibitors are expressly responsible for knowing the Barn Hunt Rules and Regulations. These may be obtained from the Barn Hunt Association website at www.barnhunt.com. Individuals who wish to obtain a Barn Hunt Registration number may do so by going to the Barn Hunt Association website noted above.
- Entries made without fees or signature or which are not accompanied by a completed waiver and indemnity form **will not be accepted.**
- Receipt of entries will be acknowledged by email within a few days, if an email address is provided. Please contact the trial secretary if you do not receive confirmation. Any errors must be reported to the trial secretary before the commencement of the trial.
- Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the trial committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, and public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other causes beyond the control of the trial committee. Abuse of any kind towards volunteers or the trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the event
- Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a refund of entry fees paid upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the trial on Saturday Afternoon. - Dogs are divided into groups by shoulder height. Small (13" and under), Medium (13.1" to 18") , Large (over 18")
- Order of judging within each class will be based on order of entries received. Dog will be staged/blinded in groups of 5 where practical and will run in height order except where multiple entries of the same handler require separation.
- All dogs must be on a short leash (6') (except when in the ring for judging) and under control at all times, while on the grounds. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. **No flexi-leads or head halters are allowed.** Dogs must run "naked" without a collar/harness. The actual course area will be securely enclosed. Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site – this includes electronic bark collars. Prong collars may be used on site while walking dogs, but are not allowed while the dog is competing.
- Bitches in season may compete. They will run at the end of each class. They must wear "pants" at all times when not being pottied, including on the course. Owners of bitches in season should confine their dogs away from the trial area and other dogs, post "dog in season" signs in their area, and potty their dogs in designated areas only. Owners must make their condition known to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trials
- The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class because the exhibitor is not ready. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready for their runs. The club has no obligation or responsibility for calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- There may be a short lunch break at the judge's discretion.
- BHA rules and common courtesy: Exhibitors are responsible for clean up after their dogs. Dispose of waste in appropriate containers provided on the site. Show courtesy to all competitors. Manage loud or disruptive dogs. Treat every dog as if they are reactive or spatially challenged and remain aware of what your dog is doing at all times. Every dog and exhibitor deserves to have a pleasant experience.

- Possessing or training with personal live quarry is not permitted on trial grounds at any time. Food and toys (unless training in the ring) are not permitted in the ring. Squeaky toys are not permitted in the building.
- These trials are being held in a covered unheated building with a sand/dirt floor. Please be prepared to Crate outside or in vehicle, and bring everything your dog will need to be comfortable. **Dogs will not be allowed in the building unless being tested.**
- **Handlers may choose to train in the ring.** Food will NOT be allowed in the ring but in the event that training is being conducted toys may be allowed. Training must be completed within the time allocated for the class. For additional detail on training in the ring please review the BHA rulebook page #5. VOLUNTEERS

The sport of Barn Hunt requires many hands to help trials and fun tests run smoothly and for participants to have a great experience both inside and outside the ring.

Volunteer jobs are not difficult, but are very important. They include activities such as:

- **Scribe** (marks score sheets based on judges calls and ensures correct dog is in the ring)
- **Leash Runner** (makes sure gate is secure, accepts leash and collar from handler, assists others)
- **Course builders**(help move bales around to set up the next class or level based on judges specifications)
- **Gate Stewards** (help folks get to and leave the ring in a timely fashion, assists others)
- **Blind Stewards** (assists gate steward, helps to manage people going into and out of the staged/blind area)
- **Rat wranglers** (inside and outside the ring) these folks take charge of the rat tube when it has been found by a dog or when it is handed outside the ring, and place the tubes in a safe designated area. (NO you do not have to actually touch any rats to do this job:)
