RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Chapter 19 – Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

LIMITED ENTRY

Entry in the rally obedience sanction match will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 teams per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. Total time allotted for judging will be 1.5 hours. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.

b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.

2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.

3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

4. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.

5. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.

6. All dogs shown in a Non-Regular or Unofficial class must be entered in one of the Official classes, or for "Exhibition Only"

7. Dogs entered "For Exhibition only" and otherwise entered only in Non-regular or Unofficial classes may be spayed or neutered

8. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.

9. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE **June 24, 2024** OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.

10. Armband numbers and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. 11. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Chair will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Whippet Club of Eastern Canada (WCEC) will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. A dog shall not be touched without permission of the owner or agent.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.

- 5. NO FOOD / water on site
- 6. Very little shade
- 7. No toys or treats allowed in the ring
- 8. No provision / refund for inclement weather

DIRECTIONS: (GPS 45 04 09.44N 74 16 37.36W) From 401:

Take exit 750 (Morrisburg), go NORTH (toward Winchester) about 22 km Turn R. onto River Rd. (1st rd. after Cass Bridge; previous Rd. = Nesbitt, also known as airport rd., on R. also); there will be a bridge across the river (South Nation) on your R. This is Nation Valley Rd.
