

Sonny Tougas National Bursary Program

Aka 'The Sonny Fund'

This Bursary is designed to aid a young person in their quest to further their education beyond secondary school. While it is within the discretion of the deciding committee, the intent is to support post-secondary education at the university, college, or technical school level.

This Bursary was founded to honour the memory of Maurice 'Sonny' Tougas, a Canadian Kennel Club All Breed Judge who passed away on October 31, 2008. Sonny had a profound impact on the sport of pure bred dogs and was instrumental in mentoring anybody who came to him for help in various aspects of our sport.

Criteria

The applicant should be a full time student and enrolled, or approved for enrolment at a university or technical college. Age is immaterial.

The applicant would have been involved in the sport of purebred dogs for a minimum of two (2) years, whether it be conformation or performance events sanctioned by the Canadian Kennel Club.

Application

In addition to the above mentioned criteria, the applicant will be expected to provide to the committee:

- 1) An academic transcript or transcripts from previous institutions that the applicant has attended
- 2) Two letters of reference which would reflect the applicants worthiness.
 - a) From a teacher or instructor
 - b) From a member of the dog community or an individual who has know the applicant for at least two (2) years
- 3) An essay no longer than 500 words reflecting the applicant's suitability for this bursary. In this essay the applicant should cover their involvement with purebred dogs. Also of critical importance in the essay, an explanation of what makes the applicant a worthy candidate for this bursary, including career aspirations and future plans should be addressed.

Amount

For the year, 2016 the bursary amount will be \$1,000.00 or more.

The recipient(s) for 2016 will be announced at the CPHA dinner on March 26, 2016
The CPHA dinner will be held in conjunction with the Battle River Canine Association, in
Camrose, Alberta.
