NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must also be entered in the regular classes or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Attention Canadian Exhibitors!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$57.60 + 5% GST.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST. 1.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to 4. indignities" - CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or Please note: electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Ann's true love in life has always been purebred dogs! Beagles are little dogs possessing the uncanny ability to capture human hearts and change the course of lives.

I grew up with dogs - a gentle but protective collie, named Lark, who accompanied me everywhere when I was a child, and a very rambunctious Labrador retriever who was my swimming companion during my teen-age years. But when young I was not involved in organized dog sports.

However, in 1994, my newly acquired companion, and now wife, Kathy, said to me, "We are a family now, and a family should have a dog." "What kind of dog do you want?" I replied. "A beagle," came the reply. "I've wanted a beagle ever since I was a little girl."

And so a few months later our first beagle puppy, Bailey, joined our family. (How many beagles are there called Bailey?) Soon we were going to dog shows, and always planning our visit to watch the beagle ring. In our minds' eyes, Bailey, who throughout his long life never entered any shows, always compared very favourably to the entrants! Bailey was the beagle who wiggled into our hearts, stimulating our love for the breed and our interest in conformation shows.

But after a few years came the desire to try it for ourselves. Soon, we had acquired another beagle puppy, Terwillegar's Tawnytakesthetown, who after earning her Canadian and American championships became the foundation dam of our kennel. Tawny is another dog who changed our lives. Since then we have bred eight litters of puppies under the Gwencalon prefix (Gwencalon being Welsh for "bright, shining heart"), all of them direct descendants of Tawny. We are currently rearing and showing her great grandchildren.

In recent years we have enjoyed a measure of success in the show ring, with two Best in Shows, multiple group placements, #2 beagle in Canada in 2012, a Best Puppy in Show at the 2013 Phoenix Beagle Club Specialty, three consecutive years in the Top 20 (U.S.) and, most recently, an Award of Merit at Westminster 2014. I could not have predicted in 1994 the extent to which two beagles would change our lives.

I view it as a great honour to be invited to judge the Beagle Club of Western Canada Sweepstakes, and thank the executives of the Club for placing their trust and confidence in me.

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show

Section 8.2.5 An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

a) registered with the CKC, b) have an Event Registration Number,

c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or

d) if it belongs to a listed breed it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

a) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;b) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of

c) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration

Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8 4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee. Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may: a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or

b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.

 $\ensuremath{\mathbf{c}}\xspace)$ in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonored cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show. Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to. Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at. a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules. Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section. Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the

Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated. Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the

breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue. Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and,
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).
- (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
