PLEASE MAKE SURE TO HAVE CASE HISTORIES AND LIST OF MEDICATIONS USED FOR THE LAST TYPE OF APPOINTMENT. This can be made available by the referring or attending Veterinary. Also, if animals have had previous eye check, please bring that form with you for the Veterinary's use only.

DIRECTIONS:

FROM SUSSEX AREA

Take Exit 446 (toward Moncton Centre/Riverview) Merge onto Berry Mills Rd/NB 128E. At lights by Moncton Coliseum turn Right onto Millennium Blvd when you see Permatile & Supplies Ltd bear left to stay on Millennium Blvd continue through the 1st set of lights and you are now on John Street the Adeline Animal Hospital is at the Corner of High and John 2nd set of Lights

FROM NOVA SCOTIA

Take Exit 459A off the Trans Canada
At the end of the exit ramp turn right onto Elmwood Drive. Go straight through 4 sets of lights. At the 5th set take right merge lane onto Morton Ave. and continue straight through 4 sets of lights, you are now on Connaught Ave. take the 1st left onto High Street and go straight. The Adeline Animal Hospital is on your left just after the 2nd set of lights. (Corner of High & John)
