The following has been copied from the CKC website:

Attention Canadian Residents

At the December Board meeting input provided by the membership was reviewed and considered to the board regarding the noticed posted to the CKC website on November 6, 2010 regarding a new Tracking fee for non-members. The Board has made changes to the original motion approved at the September Board meeting and the following motion was passed in December and therefore the following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011.

The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles.

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.


Province of Saskatchewan Guidelines

- The club will adhere to all public health guidelines in effect on the days of the tests. Spectators may be permitted if Re-open Saskatchewan permit larger crowds.
- All exhibitors, volunteers and spectators will respect each other's decision to wear protective masks or face shields if it is not mandated to do so by public health order.
- There is no smoking permitted on Test precents or property of our host. Smoking is only permitted inside your closed car.
- The Test precents will include the entire field area contained within the fence and gates as well as the potty area outside the green gate.
- There will be a \$10.00 fine for dogs loose on the field or on the host's property, including potty area. All dogs MUST be on a leash and secure collar/harness when outside their vehicle or on the track. All leashes must be held by a person, not attached to a ground stake or vehicle.
- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds.
- Muzzles and catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. Per CKC rules, no prong or shock collars are permitted on test grounds. NO FLEXI or RETRACTABLE leashes permitted on test grounds.
- The only permitted collars during a dog's run are a flat, buckle collar without hanging items. The dog may also be run without a collar. Slip, half-check, or martingale or head collars are not permitted and will result in an NQ. Harnesses must be removed.
- People are expected to clean up after their dogs. There will be a \$20.00 fine for NOT cleaning up after your dog. Dogs are not to be off leash on the venue host's property at all, including areas outside of the defined Test precents. Please do not let your dog urinate on the gates/gate posts, private vehicles or tents or anything else people have to handle. There are plenty of trees to choose from.
- The field is mowed and will be enclosed by fencing.
- All exhibitors and spectators must remain away from the drag line and out of lure operator's marked area. The Event Officials will mark an area such that the lure line will not be interfered with and the lure operator will have clear line of sight of the entire field. This is a safety issue for exhibitors and their dogs.
- All exhibitors will follow Event Officials (Event Secretary, Lure Operator, Field Marshall) instructions. Refusal to comply will result in dismissal from the trial and grounds without refund of fees.

In compliance with the health and safety guidelines, there will be NO canteen on site.

All attendees will need to bring their own water, drinks and food.

Where the rules and guidelines of social distancing differ between those the club has set out and those set for by the Province of Saskatchewan, the guidelines or rule which provides the greatest protection to the general public will stand.



DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

North from Regina or south from Saskatoon take Hwy 11 to Hwy 20 junction. Turn onto Hwy 20 towards Craven and drive 0.3 kilometers. Look for the WDOC banner on the driveway on west side of Hwy 20.

Legal Land Description: SE 4 20 21 W2 RM of Lumsden

Follow the driveway past the house and small shed. At the large metal shed turn left and follow the trail up through the black gate. Continue following the trail around and down through the red gate and into the Test field

Camping

Bathroom facilities are available. There will be **NO** cooking facilities provided. Please arrange for meals appropriately.

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How Will This Test Work?

First, the Secretary will assign each entry a group number. This number will be relayed to each entrant before the day of the Test.

The handler's meeting will be delivered via email on the Friday evening before the test. It is the handler's responsibility to read and understand. The secretary's phone will be available for calls, however, she will be setting up on the field and it may be better to text her.

On the day of the Test, dogs will be brought to the field at the time indicated for their Group number. DO NOT arrive before your group time. Competitors will not be allowed on the field until the prior group has exited. There will be no spectators permitted as part of our effort to manage our gathering size and comply with provincial regulations. Dogs are permitted ONE (1) handler to release them and ONE (1) catcher to retrieve them.

When you arrive, you will approach the secretary's tent with your dog (blue easy up at mid-field). The Test committee will assess the dog for lameness from a distance. The handlers of female dogs must bring a CLEAN and UNUSED kleenex. After their soundness check the female dog's handler will use the kleenex to wipe their dog to check that they are not in heat. The handler will present the kleenex to the Test committee from a minimum of 6 feet away.

The handler and catcher will wait at their vehicle until the dog's name is called. There will be a warmup area, however, handlers warming up their dogs should stretch them at their vehicles and make sure to keep physical distance from anyone else. There will be a potty area marked.

When the dog has completed its second run, the handler and catcher are encouraged to leave the field unless they are volunteering for the Test. Exhibitors that wish to stay the entire day MUST volunteer.

Scores will not be posted at the event. Do not congregate around the secretary's office. The time sheets will be posted on the WDOC Sprinter Events Facebook Group as soon as possible. Official results will follow after the event is done as soon as possible. Any discrepancies between score sheets and official scores must be brough to the Event Secretary's attention before Friday, September 17th.
