Important Information

- Doors will open at 1:30pm on Friday, and 8am Saturday and Sunday.
- Day of Trial entries will be accepted up to one hour before the scheduled start of each trial on Saturday & Sunday if the schedule permits. Day of Trial entries will not be available for Friday. Entries may be paid in cash (exact change only) or by EMT to NKCTreasurer@gmail.com with confirmation code provided to the Trial Secretary. Day of Trial entries are \$45 per run and \$15 per day for Exhibition Only. Please submit entries before leaving for the day if possible.
- Changes of Entry (Move Ups) will be accepted up to one hour before the start of each trial. Please submit changes of entry before leaving for the day if possible.
- Crates and crate covers are strongly recommended for all dogs.
- It is of extreme importance that everyone is vigilant about ensuring their dogs are not peeing or pooping inside the building, nor against the outside of the building or too close to the steps. Easy way to remember is to not allow your dog to pee on anything "man-made." If you see any poop, please pick it up, even if it's not yours – in Agility we call this "Adopt-a-Poop!" These issues are the #1 reason that clubs lose access to these facilities. Anyone seen not picking up poop or allowing their dog to pee on the building or near the entrances may be ejected from the trial without refund and have their future entries rejected. There are tons of green spaces away from the building for potty breaks.

NADA Policies

- Due to other activities happening at NADA between trials, we will need to set up and tear down the ring each day. You are welcome to set up crates inside, but you will need to remove your crates at the end of each day. No personal belongings may be left inside at NADA overnight. Crate set up will not be permitted until ring set up is complete each day.
- Indoor shoes (or no shoes) are required inside the NADA facility. Ideal indoor and outdoor shoes are ones you can slip into quickly, like Crocs or slippers, so you are not idling in the small porch area with your dog.
- When entering the building with your dog, please crack the door open and make sure there are no dogs in the porch before entering and give right-of-way to dogs in the porch. Likewise, when exiting the building, please crack the door and check for dogs about to enter the building. Please do not take your dog with you into the bathroom as this also creates a risk of dogs suddenly being face-to-face in the porch.
