Day of Trial entries will be accepted up to one hour before the scheduled start of each trial if the schedule permits.

Please note that entries will be accepted only thru DogShow.ca – paper entries and entries thru other online entry services will not be accepted.

Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds with a Canine Companion Number (CCN) are permitted to enter these trials.

Females in season are permitted to compete. They must be run at the end of the class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties. If your dog will be in season during the trial, you must inform the Trial Secretary immediately.

These events are being held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club.

## Fee Structure

Entry Fee per Dog per Run (Pre-Entry) - \$25.00 Entry Fee per Dog per Run (Day of Trial) - \$35.00 Listing Fee (TCN) per Dog per Class - \$11.50

Up to two dogs may be handled by the same handler in Instinct, Novice, and Open. Additional dogs will be run at the end of the class. Handlers may only handle one dog in Excellent and Master.

Important Note About Instinct: As per the CKC rule book, only dogs who have not yet earned their SDN (Scent Detection Novice) by the closing date of the trial are eligible to enter Instinct. It is not permissible for dogs who have earned their SDN or higher before the closing date to enter Instinct as a "warm up."

There will be no refunds for withdrawn entries after the closing date, or after the entry limit has been met, whichever comes first.

We currently have a rotation of veterinarians covering out of hours emergency care. Should you require emergency care please call <u>709-368-3728</u> and follow the prompts to be put in touch with the clinic on call.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**Trial Committee** 

All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the trial site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the trial grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year.

Flat ribbons will be awarded for all Qualifying Scores.

Unofficial High in Class rosettes will be awarded to the fastest team in each class. An unofficial High in Trial rosette & prize will be awarded each day to the team who qualifies in all three components at any level (excluding Instinct) with the fastest total time. A prize will also be awarded each day to the Judge's Choice. All prizes are graciously donated by our trial sponsors.

New Title rosettes will be awarded to all teams earning a new title at these trials.




