I have bred many top-winning Whippets. Can. Am. Ch. Astrologer of Alery was the first Canadian Whippet to win the American Whippet Club Specialty. Astrologer was also the top Whippet in 1980. Ch. Alery's Which Witch's Which (Witch) was another one of our Whippets who did very well.

I started judging in the early 1970s and judged in Scandinavia, Australia, USA, and Canada. I have belonged to the Guelph & District Kennel Club, Caledon Kennel Club and Trillium Dog Fanciers. I am a founding member of the Ontario Sighthound Association. I was licensed to judge Groups 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6.

2024 JUDGES' BIOGRAPHIES CONFORMATION JUDGES

FABIAN DAZA, COLOMBIA

Mr. Fabian Daza is a licensed International FCI – Association Club Canino Colombianno All Breeds Judge. Born in Barranquilla, Colombia, Fabian is a Urologist by profession. He has been involved in dog showing from an early age, but his passion for French Bulldogs began when he purchased one in 2003. Fabian started breeding French Bulldogs in a country region of Colombia. He was able to win Championship titles under the suffix Dazsan Du Upari, and since beginning his breeding, he has endeavoured to own and breed high quality, healthy specimens that compete in Colombia and in other countries across the Americas. Fabian has also bred Norwich Terriers and Bull Terriers.

For many years he has been heavily involved in the education of physicians in his specialty area through several undergraduate and postgraduate programs in Columbia. He has extended this commitment to the canine fancy. As a member of the Columbian Kennel Club Association, he participates actively in all educational events and in the process of training new judges, which he has carried out under the guidance of the Association. Fabian has been a Board Member of the Kennel Club of Bogota and is currently President of the Kennel Club of Bogota, associated with the ACCC. He has also participated in the FCI Section America and the Caribbean and been a delegate of Colombia to the General Assembly of the FCI.

Fabian has judged widely, visiting many countries of varying cultures and cynologies, through North and South America, Asia and Europe, including some excellent appointments with great judges and outstanding dogs.

RANDY GARREN, U.S.

Randy purchased his first toy poodle in 1966 with his lawn mowing money when he was 12 years old; brred his first litter a year later, and went to his first dog show in 1968. He has bred approximately 65 champions including Poodles, Dachshunds, Norfold Terrriers and Chihuahuas. Randy and his husband, Dennis McCoy, bred the top winning black poodle ever (all varieties) Ch. Randenn Tristar Affirmation. Known as Yessie, she won 103 all breed BIS.

Dennis and Randy finished more than 1,000champions and won over 500 all breed BIS. They also showed the top winning non-sporting dog in his history, Ch. Lake Cove That's My Boy with 169 all breed BIS and his grandfather Ch. Whisperewind On A Carousel with 105 all breed BIS. "Peter" was BIS at Westminster in 1991. Team Randenn piloted Ch. Spotlight's Spectacular, a Delmation, to 66 all breed BIS making her the top winning Dal of all time.

His first champion, about 1970, was a standard long dachshund. Her name was Ch. Delldach's Typhoon SL bred by Eunice Huffman. Randy also owned, bred and showed mini wires. They were house pets and truly adored!

Randy began judging in 2000 and is approved for five groups. A very popular arbiter in the US, he has also judged in Canada, Mexico, Columbia, Brazil, Argentina, Sweden, Japan, China and Australia. He feels honor and pride of being on the board of Take the Lead for many years.

ESTHER JOSEPH, AUSTRALIA

I have been involved with dogs since 1970 where my Gordon, English and, Irish Setter shared a home with a Saluki and Borzoi. I have bred Gordon Setters under the "Triseter" prefix for 50+ years and more recently (the past 20+ years) breeding and showing Pugs, I have bred English Setters, Irish Setters and owned and shown American Cockers Spaniels, Pointers and Tibetan Terriers, plus I have handled most breeds in the Gundog and many in the Toy and Terrier Groups and other groups.

At present I am the deputy Chairperson for Dogs Victoria Judges Training Program.

My home is in a beautiful country area outside of Melbourne where we have over an acre for our dogs to run free on our property. Currently we have Gordon Setters and Pugs. Our web site www.gordonsetter.com.au and Facebook is Michael Gordonsetter

My kennel name is 'TRISETER' this name came about from my heavy involvement and owning, breeding and showing three of the Setter Breeds.

I have taken many Gordon Setters and Pugs through to Best in Show at both All Breeds Shows and Speciality Shows. Over the years I have handled many different breeds, with the pinnacle being handling and winning Runner Up In Show from an entry of 291 Gordon Setters at GORDONS2000 (a Gordon Setter Speciality) in England with a Gordon Setter bitch I bred that lived in Finland, this bitches litter brother was exported to the USA and became the #1 Gordon Setter for 2003 and Crufts International Qualifier '04 '05 '06

Previous to the above I thought that my Best In Group 8 (FCI) win with a Curly Coated Retriever at the World Winners Dog Show in Finland in 1998 was one of the highlight of my show/handling career.

In Australia my pinnacle has been breeding and handling the BEST IN SHOW winner at the 2012 Royal Adelaide Show, with Gordon Setter "Supreme Ch Triseter Celtic Ice".

My'heart dog' Supreme ChTriseter Celtic Seal was a wonderful ambassador for our breed winning many Best in Shows at both all breeds and specialties.

We also have had much success showing and breeding our Pugs with many BIS wins at All Breeds level.

ANKC (Australian National Kennel Council) All Breeds Judge

Overseas I have judged at GROUP and BEST IN SHOW level and issued CACIB's & CAC's at FCI level in Denmark, Finland, Italy, Sweden, Germany, Ireland, Switzerland, Indonesia, Japan, China, Singapore, Thailand, Philippines, South Korea, Norway, Greece, and have also judged GROUP and BEST IN SHOW level in USA, New Zealand, Canada, South Africa and issued CC's England.

In 2019 I had the honor to judge the British Gordon Setter Club Championship Show of England.

At home my judging has taken me extensively throughout Australia and New Zealand, Judging the pure-bred dog has become a passion and have been invited to judge in many overseas countries listed above and have been very fortunate to be invited back numerous times.

PETER KING, AUSTRALIA

I have been in the dog world for well over 40 years, my primary interest being Gundogs. Under my Greysouthen prefix, I have successfully bred, raised, trained, exported/imported and exhibited numerous Show Champions, Grand & Supreme Champions, Retrievers and Continental Gundogs that are successful in the Field, Tracking, Endurance and dog sports. Over the years I have handled virtually every Grp 3 breed and many in Groups 1, 2, 4 & 7 at events around the world including the prestigious Crufts Show in the UK, The Nordic Winners Shows in Scandinavia, European Winners, Westminster in the USA and numerous Royal Shows in Australia.

I am a fully licensed ANKC (& FCI) Championship Judge for all Group 3 Gundogs, Group 7 Non-Sporting, (and also Group 1 Toys at Open Show level), Junior Handlers and am an ANKC Approved/Accredited Judges Assessor. I have been honoured to judge Breed, Group Specialty and All-Breeds shows (including Perth Royal Show) in every State of Australia, the North & South Islands of New Zealand & Canada. I regularly judge award CACIB's/CAC's in Thailand, Japan, Germany, Austria, Czech Republic, Belgium, Norway, Denmark, Sweden & the Baltic countries of Latvia, Estonia & Lithuania. Many of my European & Scandinavian appointments have been at some of the largest and most prestigious events including Euro Winners, Nordic Winners and numerous Breed Specialty and National Shows.

My other canine interests include RATG, Endurance, Tracking and rough shooting during the winter season. I am currently President of the Northern Gundog Society of NSW, an experienced Show Manager as well as a Royal Show Steward & Announcer ...away from the dog world, I am a keen traveller and have been a licensed Pilot for around 45 years.

MICHAEL LOOBY, AUSTRALIA

Our kennel has bred Australian champions and Supreme Champions, winning many Best in Shows.

I am honored to be the President of Sunbury Canine Club which is the biggest one-day dog show in the southern hemisphere. I am also involved with 5 other All Breeds dog clubs.

I find the breeding side of our hobby is the most fascinating part of the dog world and we spend a lot of time talking about and planning our future litters. Judging for me has been a follow on of my interest in breeding.

Some of my proudest moments have been with a Gordon Setter we bred winning BIS at Sydney Royal and BIS at Adelaide Royal. To me the pinnacle has been the many Gordon Setters we have exported around the world that have won and are still winning BIS which has set the standard of what a Gordon Setter should be.

I have judged in every State in Australia and had the pleasure of judging overseas. I have awarded, CAC's and CACIB's at FCI level in Germany, Switzerland, Thailand, Korea and have also judged in USA, New Zealand, South Africa, Japan and Canada

I am a recognized breeder of English Setters, Old English Sheepdogs and Miniature Schnauzers, with the Kennel name "B.I.S". I bred many champions and had at least one World Champion in each of the breeds of my kennel.

My dogs obtained four times the TOP DOG all breeds ranking in Argentina and foreign countries, winning BIS even in USA. In the three breeds my dogs were many times Best of Breed in the year and Best of Group, getting many BIS.

I breed Miniature Schnauzers and Cairn Terriers and my dogs are #1 in my country.

Top Dog All breeds 2015 with a Cairn Terrier World record breaker.

My latest Schnauzer breeding won B.O.B at Westminster Kennel Club, 2018

D. SCOTT PFEIL, U.S.

D. Scott Pfeil has been actively involved in the sport of purebred dogs for over thirty years. A sighthound specialist, he has been successful in breeding and exhibiting Afghan Hounds, Greyhounds, Salukis, and Italian Greyhounds. He has bred or owned #1 dogs in each of these breeds and collectively his dogs have won over eighty All-Breed Bests in Show and countless specialities.

Scott began judging in 2004 and is currently approved to judge all hounds as well as a selection of working and toy breeds. He has had the privilege of judging prestigious all-breed and specialty shows throughout the USA, Canada, Mexico, Australia, Germany, and Japan. Highlights include the AKC National Championship, the Afghan Hound Club of America National, and the Donaueschingen Sighthound Festival.

Scott is a principal owner (along with Erika Wyatt) of the International Kennel Club of Chicago which hosts two major clusters of shows each year billed as The Great American Dog Show. He is also president of the Afghan Hound Club of America, vice-president of the Chicagoland Hound Association, and serves on the boards of the Northeastern Illinois Kennel Club and Greater Chicago Afghan Hound Club.

JUAN PIO MILANO RUIZ, CHILE

Juan Pío Milano is an all-breed conformation judge (with FCI and AKC licenses), breeder, handler and groomer with experience in breeds such as Afghan Hounds, Poodles, Bouvier des Flandres, American Cocker Spaniels and Bichon Frisés.

Born in Chile, in the heart of a family for which the love for animals was one of its main values, he got involved in the world of dog breeding when, once he became financially independent, he acquired his first American Cocker Spaniel. This dog led him to Ramón Podestá, breeder and owner of Von Haussman Kennels, a world renown dog kennel with which he has collaborated for more than 20 years.

Since then, Juan Pío Milano has been able to successfully take part in dog shows in various countries such as Argentina, Germany, Uruguay, United States, Brazil, Spain, Chile and Peru, to name a few, where, particularly as the handler of the Von Haussman Afghan Hounds, he has piloted dogs to important victories in shows such as Americas and the Caribbean, SICALAM, Afghan Hound Club of America National Specialty, Eukanuba World Challenge, AKC National Championship, Donaueschingen Sighthound Festival and World Dog Shows. More recently, in 2022, Juan Pío Milano had the honor of handling the Afghan Hound bitch Ch. Jalila bint Sirag von Haussman, who was the BOG winner of the FCI group 10 at the World Dog Show held in Madrid and a recipient of the FCI Dog of the Year Title.

As a groomer, Juan Pío Milano has attended different seminars and demonstrations as an apprentice, lecturer and judge. Approved to judge all breeds by both the FCI and the AKC, he has had the pleasure of judging in countries such as Chile, Argentina, Brazil, Puerto Rico and the United States of America.

BEA SAWKA, ONTARIO, CANADA

Bea has owned, bred and handled Bearded Collies since obtaining her first dog in 1976 and has bred over 200 Champions in many countries. Her Beardies have won more than 65 BCCC Annual Awards, numerous Specialties including 20 National Specialties and approximately 120 All Breed Best In Shows.

She bred, owned and handled Canada's Top Dog All Breeds in 1997 – Harrison, Can. Am. Ch. Classical Image Of A Legend. She has had the Top Winning Beardies in Canada and the US on numerous occasions including the #1 Beardie in the US and the #1 Beardie in Canada in 2015. Most recently, #1 Beardie in Canada in 2022 and #3 in the US in 2023 in only 3 weekends of shows.

She has owned and bred many outstanding dogs that have gone on to be the foundation of some of the most successful Bearded Collie kennels around the world.

In 2003 she obtained our first "Havanese" and now shares her home with several of them.

She also co-owned the #1 Pointer in Canada 2018, 2019 and 2020, Stewart, MBIS, Can. GchEx. Am.Ch. Seasyde Some Guys Have All The Luck and the #1 Pointer in Canada in 2021; and 2022, Riggs, Gch Seasyde Casino.

She began judging in 2012 and has judged in several countries.

DAVID A STRACHAN, AUSTRALIA

Mr. David A Strachan began his career in dogs in 1970 when he acquired his first Boxer which also happened to be his first show specimen winning his class & first "blue" ribbon. There started the show bug which was to influence the direction of his life for the next 50 years plus. He has had much success as a breeder and exhibitor of Boxers and Boston Terriers, having bred (or) owned over 100 champions and these dogs have won over 150 Best Exhibit in Show awards.

David's significant dogs include his Boxers - Grand Champion Thasrite Prince Charming SOM (now inducted into Aust Dog World Hall of Fame) winner of 27 Best in Shows who was also NSW CC Show Dog of the Year in 1993 and BIS at the Canberra Royal Show in 1992 and Australia's No. 1 Boxer 1992/93/94 and Grand Champion Thasrite Topless Bikini (AI) DOM who won 26 All Breed BIS and was the No. 1 Boxer in Australia for 1998 and 1999 and among the top show dogs all breeds during those years.

His other notable breedings are, Grand Ch Thasrite Melodrama (who won 15 BIS) and BIS/BISS Aust Grand Ch/ RSA Ch Thasrite The New Yorker SOM (BOB/Group 2 Sydney Royal 2003) a winner of some 20 BIS awards (in Aust and RSA) and Australia's #1 Boxer 2003/04. He also, successfully campaigned in Queensland in partnership the multi-BIS winner Grand Ch Thasrite Angel's Brat.

David began judging in 1987 and since then has been a sought after International all breeds' judge. His judging career has taken him to many parts of the world, including England, Ireland, Canada, the USA, Sweden, Norway, Finland, Germany, Denmark, India, South Africa, New Zealand, Malaysia, Thailand, South Korea, Taiwan, Indonesia, Singapore, Russia, Japan, Hong Kong, Vietnam, China and the Philippines.

In recent years David has also been involved in breeding &/or exhibition of Pugs and Labrador Retrievers. He has been involved in dog show administration for many years in varied capacities of show manager, club secretary and until recently all breeds dog club president for over 10 years.

David has also been involved in judges' training, examination and is an ANKC Accredited Assessor in JTS. He has been involved in lectures and seminars in his home country of Australia and also invited to play an active role in judges' training, examinations and seminars in the Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, South Korea and India on a number of occasions.

JOHN WADE, U.S.

John Wade became active in purebred dogs in 1959 and has stayed continuously involved ever since.

Early on, he worked for an AKC Licensed All Breed Handler and two terrier breeding kennels, eventually becoming a Handler. He also enjoyed success as a breeder and exhibitor of all 3 coats of Dachshunds with numerous top winning Smooth Dachshunds either owned or bred by the Wade Family.

He further pursued his commitment to the sport and became a multiple-group and Best in Show judge. Employed on two occasions by the American Kennel Club as a member of their Executive Field Staff and Director of Judging Operations he has deep knowledge of the inner workings of the sport. He encourages open discussion between Breeders, Exhibitors and himself and remains approachable for any healthy conversation about the breed and for the history of the Dachshund in America to be passed onto future generations.

WOOD WORNALL, U.S.

I was born in Kansas City, Missouri. I gradated from Southern Methodist University a degree in political science. Although I had ambitions to go into politics my life took a turn in a different directions. I became interested in breeding and exhibiting pure bred dogs. During the summer breaks from college I went to work for the great terrier handler, Ric Chashoudian. Upon graduation, I continued to work for Ric for 7 years. I started my own handling business professionally and continued for the next 40 years.

During that time, I bred wire fox terriers as well as Cavalier King Charles spaniels. I bred over 50 champions in each of these breeds under the Crizwood prefix.

While showing, I handled many best in show winners. One such dogs, was he top winning welsh terrier of all time with 100 best in shows! One of only 12 dogs to have amassed such a record. Along with my daughter, Jenny, we have handled the top winning welsh terrier of all time, top winning Airedale of all time, top winning French Bulldog of all time, and one the top winning beagles of all time.

Over the course of my career, I have had the honor to handle best in show winners in 5 groups and winners in all 7 groups.

After a long and dedicated career, I retired from handling and enjoy the judging of dogs.

It is my continuing passion to travel the world and judge dogs with enthusiasm.

Class Structure (Age Requirements)

1. PEE WEE

4 years of age up to 6 years of age. Optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded, participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

2A. JUNIOR NOVICE

For handlers 7 to 10 years who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

2B. JUNIOR OPEN

For handlers 7 to 10 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.

3A. INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

3B. INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.

4A. SENIOR NOVICE CLASS

For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

4B. SENIOR OPEN CLASS

For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.

5. BEST OVERALL

Optional at the discretion of the host club.

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the show.

Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler. If Pee Wee handler cannot lift dog, it is not appropriate in size for the competitor.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards:Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

(C) SENIOR OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

(D) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to com-pete in this class.
