# **MOCK POINTING BREEDS FIELD DOG TESTS**

~ **Training Event** ~

**Friday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

**12:00 - 4:00**

**Check-In: 11:30 am**

**Kerkoven Farms, Deroche BC**

This training event will help you to learn about field dog tests for pointing breeds *and* have an opportunity to practice handling your dog under test-like conditions. The event will run like a CKC Pointing Breeds Field Dog Test. *No points or awards will be given.* This is purely a chance for you to learn and train with your dog under test-like conditions. *Space is limited!*

### **ITINERARY:**

- ✓ Talk: Introduction to CKC Field Dog Test standards of performance with Q&A for participants (20 minutes)
- ✓ Mock Test (limited to 10 dogs)
- ✓ Training setups to practice foundation work with your dog will be available throughout the afternoon

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- Every participant is expected to help with bird planting. Understanding bird planting is essential to becoming a proficient handler in these events and learning to train your dog!
- Every participant is expected to follow along other participants. The session leaders will act as “judges” and give feedback to help you work through training situations as they arise in the mock test. Watching others work through training situations will accelerate your problem solving for your own dog!
- You will be able to train your dog on course; Please maintain good sportsmanship and respect.
- There will be stations set up while the mock test is ongoing for you to train your dog at.

Please familiarize yourself with the **CKC Field Dog Tests Rules and Regulations for Pointing Breeds** (<https://www.ckc.ca/en/Events/Overview-of-Events/Pointing-Field-Trials-Tests> ). Section 10 explains the standards of performance for each test level.

### **COST:**

\$30 per handler with 1 dog; \$10 per additional dog (*same handler*)

\$20 for people auditing with no dog

*These fees help us offset the costs of running the event: birds, porta-potty, land, etc.*

### SITE:

There are no hook-ups and no potable or running water on site. Bring water for yourself and your dogs. A porta-potty will be provided on-site.

### CONDUCT:

### WHAT TO BRING:

- Food, snacks, water for you and your dog
- Chair
- Appropriate clothing & footwear for the conditions (will go ahead rain or shine)
- A way for your dog to wait/rest when they are not working (crate, staked out, or in your vehicle)
- Training equipment: long line, leash, flat collar, training collar (if applicable), starter pistol, etc.

### DIRECTIONS: *Kerkoven Farms, Nicomen Island*

**From Vancouver:** East on Hwy 1– North on the McCallum turnoff – through Abbotsford to Mission – East on Loughheed Hwy (#7) to the stop sign (it's in center of hwy). Following #7 turn right over the railroad tracks & over the bridge at Nicomen Slough, continue on Loughheed Hwy (#7) over the island to Athey Road (just before the bridge to get off island), turn right and follow Athey Road to the end (keeping to the right).

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you went into Deroche – *you have gone too far* – turn around, come back over the bridge and turn left at the first road (Athey Road)

Watch for the signs, they will help "Point" the way!
