\*ASCA<sup>®</sup> (Australian Shepherd Club of America) Obedience is open to all breeds and mixed breeds. To earn ASCA titles/legs, a non-ASCA-registered dog needs an ASCA Tracking Number which costs \$10 (Lifetime number), plus \$10 for the owner's Service Membership. (ie. for multiple dogs: \$20.00 total for first dog and \$10 for each additional dog). The Service Membership does not have to be renewed.

If your dog already has a Tracking Number (from last year or prior) please be sure to bring it with you.
