COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL FOR THE BMDCC All Breed Draft Tests Oct 23 & 24, 2021

If you cannot comply with these rules Please Do Not Enter

The current NB State of Emergency dictates that:

Effective September 22, all individuals aged 12 and older will be required to provide proof of full vaccination for access to some events, services and businesses.

Judges, Stewards, Entrants, & Volunteers MUST show proof of full vaccination

- THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN IT IS POSSIBLE until the Provincial Government of New Brunswick lifts such restrictions.
- COVID WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED by Judges, Stewards, Entrants, Handlers, & Volunteers
- Contact tracing information including names and telephone numbers must be provided on a daily basis
- These Draft Tests are **NOT OPEN** to the General Public (sorry this means **NO** spectators at these tests).
- MANDATORY MASKS MUST BE WORN correctly over mouth and nose by Exhibitors, Judges and Stewards at all times when social distancing outside is not possible. Judges will provide more directions during their briefing the morning of the test for masking.
- MANDATORY MASKS MUST ALSO BE WORN: in all indoor spaces, which includes the Port-a-Potty and in any other location where Social Distancing cannot be maintained.
- MANDATORY SOCIAL DISTANCING will be required in the rings, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table
- SHOW SITE ACCESS PROCESS: Proof of full vaccines to be shown for admittance. Waiver is to be handed into the show secretary and the Contact Tracing sheet filled in upon entrance to property by each person. Each person will be asked the Covid survey questions and asked to sanitize their hands. Each person must have their mask on correctly.
- The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations. There will be a Limited supply of masks in case someone needs one. It is encouraged that <u>entrants Be Self -sufficient</u>: Bring sanitizer, personal use masks, water, chair, snacks & their own lunch. There will be no public seating provided.
- Note that this protocol is subject to change depending on New Brunswick Public Health restrictions at the time of the Shows.
