General Information

- 1. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules. Copies of the Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials Regulations & Standards may be purchased from the CKC. Only certain sections of the rules are highlighted under General Information, so they should not be considered to be complete.
- 2. Pinch/prong collars are not permitted on the trial site.
- **3**. BITCHES IN SEASON Refund of entry will be made for bitches who come into season after entries close. Request in writing must be submitted to Trial Secretary with certificate from a veterinarian <u>on or before</u> the day of the Trial.
- **4.** CONTAGIOUS DISEASE Refund of entry (less CKC fee) will be made for dogs that are under a veterinarian's care for contagious disease diagnosed after entries close. Request in writing must be submitted to Trial Secretary along with a letter from a veterinarian <u>on or before</u> the day of the Trial.
- **5.** CKC Obedience rules state that "A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
- **6.** CKC Rally Obedience rules state that "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Rally Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."
- 7. A dog which has earned its Obedience CD title in the USA or any foreign country is not eligible for entry in the Novice A class. A dog which has earned its CDX in the USA or any foreign country is not eligible for entry in the Open A class. Such dogs must be entered in the respective B classes. Licensed handlers, trainers and persons who have previously exhibited a dog through its Utility Dog title in Canada or elsewhere are not eligible for entry in the A classes; they must enter the B classes.
- **8.** A dog which has earned a CKC Rally Novice title or any CKC Novice Obedience title may not enter Rally Novice A. Only the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families may handle a dog in the A classes. Likewise, a dog which holds a CKC Novice Obedience title and the relevant Rally title may not be entered in the A classes. Licensed handlers and trainers are not eligible to handle a dog in the A classes; they must enter B classes.
- **9.** If entering a dog in either <u>Obedience</u> [Novice Intermediate, Open or Utility], or <u>Rally Obedience</u> [Rally Advanced or Excellent Classes], PLEASE INDICATE JUMP HEIGHTS ON ENTRY FORMS.
- **10.** Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or who made the errors.
- 11. The precincts of the trials will include the 2 gated rings and 5 metres outside each ring.
- 12. Only dogs entered in the trials or in the CKC Canine Good Neighbour test will be allowed in the building.
- 13. Identification cards and Judging schedules will be distributed to exhibitors as soon as possible after entries close.
- 14. All dogs that are foreign born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of earning points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at (416) 675-5511
- **15.** The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability, in the event of accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The Trial Committee will not be responsible for dogs or property at the trial site.
- **16.** If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refund of entries will be made.
- 17. Moving up: A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN, or a MCN & has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the rules may be moved to the next level of competition. When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is moved up to, schedule permitting.


