CKC REGULATION: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

The tendering of NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Exhibitors whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted.

CLASSES, TITLES & AWARDS:

Titles may be earned by class or by component. A dog may be entered in either the class or the component they are eligible for. Titles will be awarded once requirements are met for the class or component. For complete details:

ENTRY LIMIT: These Trials are limited by time. If the trial fills, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added. Handlers may only enter 1 dog in each component at each level. Dogs can only be entered in Open, Excellent and Masters if they have already obtained the preceding level title.

MOVE UPS: No Move-ups will be allowed at this trial

JUDGING SCHEDULES: sent to exhibitors after the closing date

EQUIPMENT: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds.

PENALTIES ISSUED BY THE CLUB: Dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination. Contamination of the search area, at the discretion of the Judge may result in a non-qualifying score. Any dog that urinates or defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the class and will result in a non-qualifying score.

SCENT DETECTION RULEBOOK: It is up to the individual handler to review the CKC Scent Detection Rulebook of most recent (January 1st, 2024).

REMINDERS: That anyone discussing hides before the end of class briefing with the judge will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.

All dogs are to be on leash while in the parking lot or any areas surrounding the trial venue. Only time a dog may be off leash is during a search and at the discretion of the judge.

Handlers With Multiple Dogs: Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than one dog in the same class / components. i.e.: Two novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial. The handler may enter one dog in Instinct, and one dog in Novice as an alternative.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are permitted to compete. However, they must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitting panties.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL AND VENUE INFORMATION:

1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the trial. The Event Chairperson shall have full control of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the chairperson or veterinarian for any reason, shall not, after being excused compete in any class for any award for the balance of the trial.
3. The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability for, either dogs, exhibitors or patrons in the event of an accident or misfortune.
4. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
5. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there is no refund of entry.
6. Schedules are based on 9 minutes per dog for Novice and Open, 14 minutes per dog for Excellent, and 17 minutes per dog for Masters (all components).
7. Please allow for absentees and variances in the rate of judging.
8. Please Obey ENTER and EXIT gates in the trial area.
9. Dogs and equipment shall not be left unattended at the trial venue.
10. Dogs must be on leash at all times inside the trial venue and trial grounds.
11. Exhibitors will be required to crate their dogs in their vehicle. Please be prepared for all types of weather.
12. Access to parking will be allowed starting at 7:30 am. Please obey Parking Attendant
13. Exhibitors are expected to maintain a clean area. Please be considerate when utilizing any facilities. No dogs are permitted in the washrooms.
14. Bring your own food and drinks, for yourself and your dog.
15. No overnight recreational parking will be provided.
16. Exhibitors and Participants are expected to follow these event guidelines. Failure to comply may result in excusal from the remainder of this event. The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and the venue, which are governed by CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB (CKC) rules.

SITE INFO

No special area will be designated for reactive dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the trial where off leash searches are permitted. Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site. Please, clean up after yourself and your dog. Please note: some search areas accessed by stairs.

NO CONCESSION ON SITE: Restaurants are available within walking distance of the location, or bring your own food, treats and water for you and your dog(s)

CANCELLATION OF EVENT: If the Tyee Kennel Club needs to cancel the event due to Provincial or Federal regulations, all entry fees will be returned with the exception of any fees collected by Dogshow.ca.

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10.50 including GST) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies. I (we) agree to hold the Tye Kennel Club and the Cowichan Valley K9 Noseworks group and their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
