Judging will commence at 12:00 noon on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday & Sunday unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. All Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each group.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

The correct wearing of Masks (covering nose & mouth) is encouraged at all times within the Show Precincts by all Participants, as well as Social Distancing & Frequent Hand Washing.

If the Judge requests that exhibitors wear a mask while in the ring, masks will be worn.

- No post-dated cheques are accepted. All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$35.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.
- Entries must be submitted by mail (to the Show Secretary), hand-delivered (to 214 Crossley Ave, Truro NS) or via the Entry Line. No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events.

Please Note: Credit Card payments/Fax Entries/eTransfers are accepted **ONLY** through THE ENTRY LINE. The Evangeline Kennel Club does not accept credit cards for payment.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes: It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and Regulation. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

REFUND POLICY

If, due to COVID, these Shows are not able to be held; refunds will be issued to exhibitors - MINUS Administration Fees. While all efforts will be taken to expedite refunds, they may take up to 14 days (depending on volume & other work commitments).

If because of; an act of God, riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations, or decree, or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the EKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated. Thank you

Junior Handling (Conformation)

Junior handling will be held Saturday & Sunday during the lunch break. Dogs competing in junior handling must be entered in the show in one of the regular classes or in exhibition only. Registration will take place in the morning (by 11:00 am) at the Secretary's table. Entry fee is \$2.00.

1. Grooming Space & Set-Up

EKC will be renting prime indoor 10ft x 10ft grooming spaces which includes 2 electrical outlets for the 3 days - \$60.00 total. For more information contact: cremme@eastlink.ca to reserve your space. PLEASE NOTE: Only Exhibitors renting a space allowed to set up indoors for these shows. All other Exhibitors are welcome to set up in the designated parking areas free of charge. There will be NO power supplied outdoors.

2. 50/50 Tickets

Tickets will be sold on 2 separate 50/50 draws, 1 each on Saturday (draw time 3:00 pm) and Sunday (draw time 2:00 pm). Ticket prices are \$5.00 each or 3 for \$10.00

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - **Effective January 1, 2023**

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). **Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.**

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.**

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified.

Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/ MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension. Please forward your request to:

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line.) The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received on or before the closing date and time. Official CKC Entry Forms MUST be used. Please PRINT OR TYPE YOUR ENTRIES. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that the full name and address of the owners must be filled in.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show/trials Secretary after the closing date and time.
6. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the CKC may compete in these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close.
8. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries before the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.



GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Evangeline Kennel Club, its officers, associates, and Show Committee, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- The Evangeline Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left on site overnight, or on the show premises
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials, which are governed by CKC rules
- **The site will be open no earlier than 11:00 am Friday, June 23rd for set-up. The site will be open at 7:00 AM Saturday and Sunday.**
- **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT ON-SITE OVERNIGHT.**
- BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
- Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes before the commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- **Please keep your dogs crated when unattended, and clean up after your dogs.**
- **SHOW PRECINCTS - The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers.**
- The welfare of an exhibitors child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises.
- The building will be closed 30 minutes after the completion of judging for the day.
- Puppy for Sale or Dog for Sale signs will not be permitted in the building.
- There will be no prong/spike collars or Flexi leads permitted in the venue.
- Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or in harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table or left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed safely by the proper authorities.
- Dog Bathing is available on the outside of the building - cold water only.
- Exhibitors, Handlers, Judges and Volunteers are expected to participate with honesty, fairness and integrity, ever mindful of the practice of "good sportsmanship", before, during, and after the EKC show. Any person engaging in an activity that might be considered malicious, threatening or constitutes bullying, will be asked to leave the show.

Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over, not in competition.
Veteran Class Dogs	Must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.
Altered class	For sexually altered dogs only

NOTE: 4-6-month Exhibition only puppy~ if the puppy does not yet have a CKC Registration Number the Listing Fee is waived.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at any single show.

Grand Champions and GCH Points

Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch).

The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021, may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHEX POINTS The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

Section 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) One (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) Three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) A CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Section 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, three (3) Group wins, or three (3) Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.
