Temporary Competition Number

(TCN) (Replaced Listing)

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). The current TCN fee is \$10.50 per dog/day.

A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. All owners of unregistered, CKC-recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN).

Event Registration Number:

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation.

Non-Member Participation Fee:

An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Puppy Stake:

"A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged."

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2

Novice Stake:

"A Novice Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial (with no age limit) that have not placed in an All-Age Stake."

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 7

<u>Limit Stake:</u>

"A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial."

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 3

Amateur All-Age Stake: "An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur."

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 6

Open All-Age Stake:

"An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged."

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4

Points:

Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, with 10 or more starters.

1st place (5) Points 2nd place (3) Points 3rd place (2) Points 4th place (1) Points

Prizes: CKC rosettes will be presented to all placing dogs in each stake.

> trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this

Dog Health:

Please ensure all rabies shots are up to date.

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); or
- has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

CESSC reserves the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Food & Meals:

A full concession will be available for all competitors, volunteers, and spectators all three days, both breakfast & lunch - \$5 and \$7.50 respectively. Thursday evening, we ask you bring a potluck appetizer. Dinner will be served at the trial on Friday & Saturday – Menu to be determined. Tickets for each dinner (Fri & Sat) will be only \$20/night.
