## Junior Handling Friday July 22, 2016 TIME: Tp be announced

Junior Handling Judge Barbara Turpin All Classes for Junior Handling

Entries will be accepted at the Show Secretary's Desk up to 12:00 am on Friday with no exceptions.

There is no Fee.

The following classes will be provided:

- 4.1.1 Classes in Junior Conformation Handling competition shall be divided by age as follows:
- (a) **Pee Wee Class** This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.
- (b) **Junior Novice Class** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.
- (c) **Junior Open Class** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition.
- (d) **Intermediate Novice Class** This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.
- (e) **Intermediate Open Class** This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.
- (f) **Senior Novice Class** This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.
- (g) **Senior Open Class** This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

#### NOTE: PEE WEES do not compete for Best Overall.

Competition is open to all Juniors between the age of 4 up to 18 years of age (of the competition year). DOGS HANDLED BY THE JUNIORS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS AT THE Specialty on Friday July 21, 2016

#### DOGS NEED NOT BE OWNED BY THE JUNIOR.

A rosette will be offered for FIRST IN EACH CLASS (except Pee Wee class entrants, who will receive a Participant flat ribbon). A rosette and prize will be awarded for BEST OVERALL HANDLER. Ribbons will be awarded to second through fourth in each class., The use of bitches in season in any Junior competition will not be permitted;

Eligibility of Dog (sec. 3.5) has had additions —"Every dog entered in the regular shows or trials, or for Exhibition Only, is eligible for entry into Junior Handling Conformation or Junior Handling Obedience provided it meets one of the following:

- (a) Conformation
- (i) Registered with the CKC,
- (ii) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (iii) Eligible for registration with the CKC; or
- (iv) If it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

#### 3.4 Entries

3.4.1 Junior Handlers with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.

### Sweepstakes—Barbara Turpin

Friday July 22—Before Specialty Judging All dogs six months and under eighteen months of age shall be eligible to compete, All dogs must be entered in one of the regular Breed classes. The classes in the Sweep-stakes are divided by sex and offered as follows:

Junior Puppy 6 months and less than 9 months
Senior Puppy 9 months and less than 12 months
Yearly Puppy 12 months and less than 18 months

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above classes will be brought together for the final placing of "Best in Sweepstakes" and "Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes"

#### **PRIZES**

Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 25% of the Entry Fees received and a Rosette. Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 20% of the Entry Fees received and a Rosette. First Place winners in each class will receive 3.75% of Entry Fees and a Rosette. 2nd to 4th place in each class will receive a Flat Ribbon. The Club will retain the remaining entry fees to defray costs.

#### **CHAMPIONS AND**

#### CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog.

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. **Entries positively close 12 noon PDT Thursday June 30, 2016,** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 6. There is no refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if an entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 7. Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards will be given at the show.
- 8. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. or returned item will be subject to a minimum \$50.00 service charge.

#### **Non Member**

#### **Participation Fee**

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a <u>Canadian</u> non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

#### **CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2006**

- 8.2.5 An error in the class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show.
- 8.5.8 In the case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes within the show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition (armband) number. A new entry, along with accompanying entry fees and listing fees (if applicable), will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the opening of the show (see section 3.32, 3.51 & 8.5.4)
- 8.9.3 When one or more all-breed and/or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the all breed or Specialty show.
- 12.3.1 A Puppy awarded Best Puppy in Group is NOT required to stay for Best Puppy in Show
